

Notice of Pending Application/Public Hearing for Proposed Wetland Individual Permit

Bridge Development Partners, LLC, c/o Mark Houser, 1000 Irving Park Rd., STE 150, Itasca, IL 60143 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to discharge dredged or fill material into wetlands.

The project is located in the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 24 & 25, Township 2 North, Range 21 East, City of Kenosha, Kenosha County.

The proposed improvements that impact wetlands include installation of a 15-inch sanitary sewer main, widening of 38th Street (between 128th Avenue and 120th Avenue), an extension of 128th Avenue (between STH 142 and 38th Street), and widening of a portion of STH 142 (at the intersection of 128th Avenue). In total, 2.26 acres of wetlands are proposed to be impacted as a result of this project; with approximately 1.97 acres of permanent wetland impact and 0.29 acre of temporary wetland impact. The road and utility improvements stem to provide infrastructure to support commercial development and extension of municipal service areas.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 281.36, 401 CWA, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity.

The Department scheduled a public hearing on this activity or project because the Department received a request for a public hearing. The hearing will be a public informational hearing where members of the public can learn more about the proposed activity and submit written or oral comments about the waterway and project in light of the legal standards above.

Comments should include the docket number or applicant name, and should relate to whether the project meets the legal standards listed above. Comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days after the date that the public informational hearing is completed in order for them to be considered.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
