

### Notice of Public Hearing for Proposed Pier and Riprap

James Federighi, 580 Red Cypress Drive, Cary, IL 60013 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to install riprap on the banks of/and place a pier on the bed of Geneva Lake.

The project is located in the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 17 East, Town of Linn, Walworth County.

The project involves two components. One phase involves shoreline erosion protection via the installation of 100 linear feet of rock riprap utilizing existing rock and new 6-24 inch quarry stone. The second phase involves construction of a 2 boat slip pier with a main walkway 8 feet wide by 100 feet long and anchored by 9 cribs. The pier will include catwalks marking the 2 boat slip areas. A 12 foot by 14 foot canoe/kayak landing will be installed along the shoreline.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11 and 30.12(3m), Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity.

The Department scheduled a public hearing on this activity or project because the Department received a request for a public hearing. The hearing will be a public informational hearing where members of the public can learn more about the proposed activity and submit written or oral comments about the waterway and project in light of the legal standards above.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the permit decision document.
