Detailed information: On April 1, 2015, the DNR issued a general Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) Permit, No. WI-0063835-02-0, to regulate the discharge of ballast water from any vessel entering Lake Michigan, Lake Superior, or other waters where a vessel may transit located within the boundaries of Wisconsin. On April 28, 2015, the Lake Carriers' Association, the Interlake Steamship Company, Key Lakes, Inc., Grand River Navigation Company, Inc., Central Marine Logistics, Inc., and Pere Marquette Shipping Company filed a Petition for a Contested Case Hearing with the DNR to review the reasonableness of and necessity for certain terms in the permit, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 283.63 and Wis. Admin. Code Chapter NR 203. By letter dated May 14, 2015, the DNR granted the request for contested case hearing.
