



Original Vegetation

- White pine/Red pine
- Jack pine, scrub (hill's), oak forest and barrens
- Aspen, white birch, pine
- Beech, sugar maple, basswood, red oak, white oak, black oak
- Sugar maple, basswood, red oak, white oak, black oak
- Oak- white oak, black oak, bur oak
- Oak openings - bur oak, white oak, black oak
- Prairie
- Brush
- Swamp conifers - white cedar, black spruce, tamarack, hemlock
- Lowland hardwoods - willow, soft maple, box elder, ash, elm
- Marsh and sedge meadow, wet prairie, lowland shrubs
