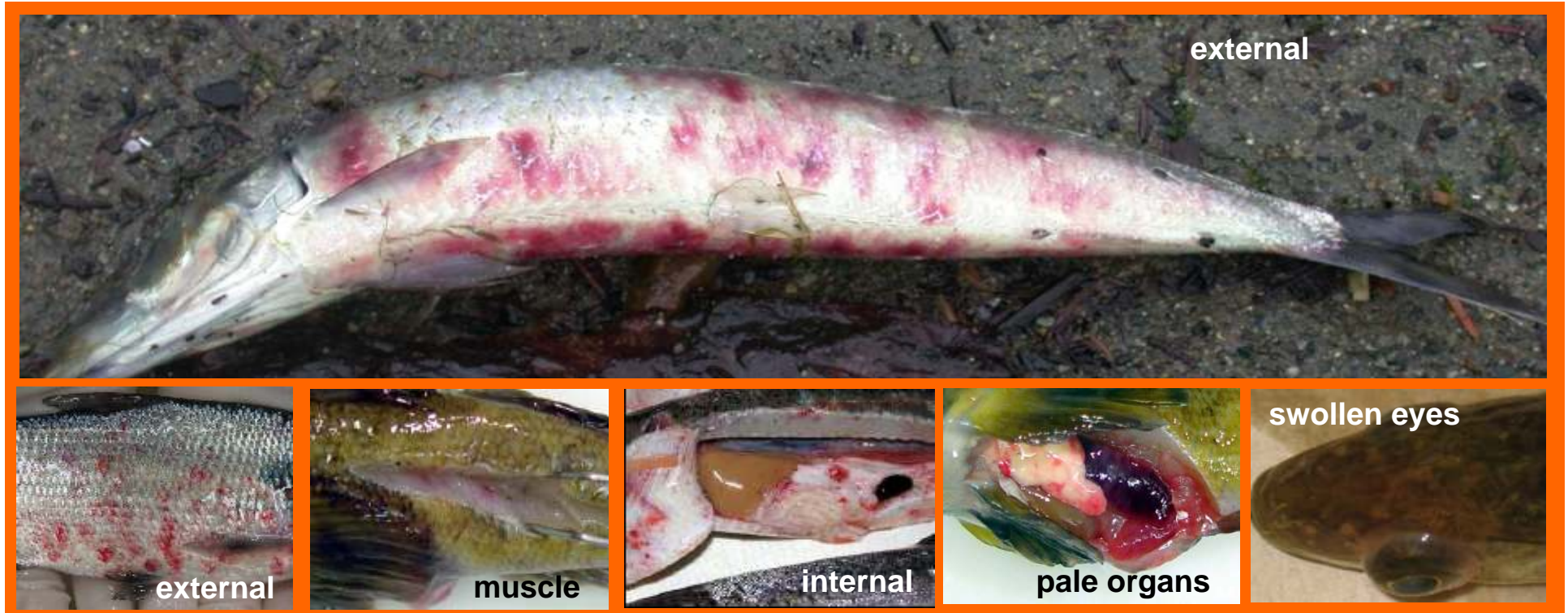


! VHS ALERT !

BOATERS & ANGLERS

Do not move water and live fish (including bait fish) from this water.



Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia (VHS) virus is affecting fish species in Wisconsin. The virus is not a threat to people who want to eat their catch. YOU can help control the spread of this virus and other invasive species:

- ! Drain all water from your boat and trailer, containers, and fishing equipment including bait buckets and coolers.
- ! Do not move live fish, including unused minnows, from these waters. All fish must be dead before leaving the landing or shoreline. Ice your catch and discard your minnows in a waste receptacle.
- ! Do not use minnows unless they were purchased from a licensed Wisconsin bait dealer or you caught them from the water you are fishing.
- ! Remove all visible plants, animals, and mud from your boat and trailer.
