NEW rules prohibit the movement of water and live fish (including bait fish) from this water.



Viral Hemorrhagic Septicemia (VHS) virus is affecting many fish species in the Great Lakes Basin. The virus does not represent a health hazard to humans. YOU can help control the spread of this virus and other invasive species:

- ⚠ Drain all water from your boat and trailer, containers, and fishing equipment including bait buckets and coolers.
- ⚠ Do not move live fish from this water. All fish must be dead before leaving the landing or shoreline.
- ⚠ Do not use dead bait preserved only by freezing or refrigeration in any water except Lake Michigan and Green Bay.
- ⚠ Remove all visible plants, animals, and mud from your boat and trailer.
