



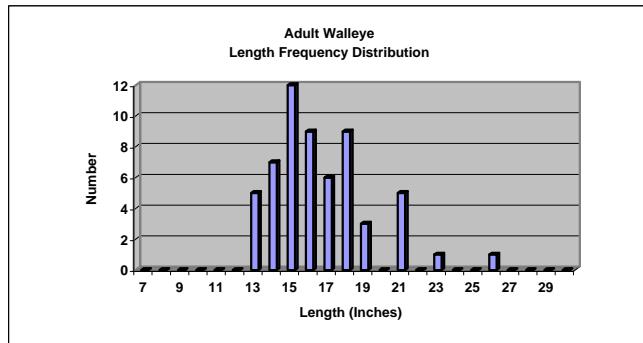

The Department of Natural Resources conducted a fisheries assessment of Little Yellow Lake, Burnett County, from April 26, 2008 to April 30, 2008.

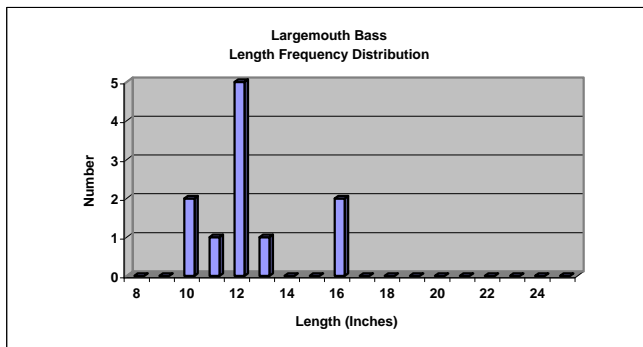
Little Yellow Lake is a drainage lake in the St. Croix basin. The walleye fishery is supported primarily through stocking. The population estimate for adult walleye is less than area lakes with similar characteristics.



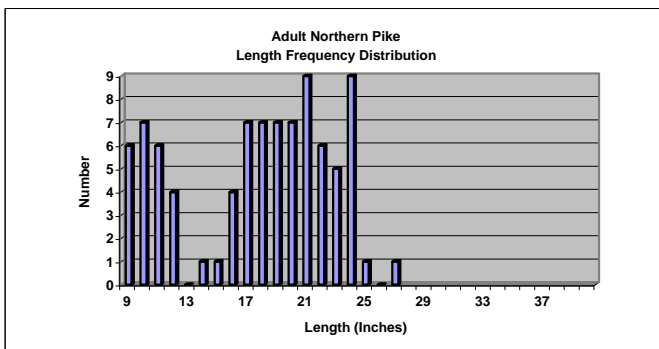

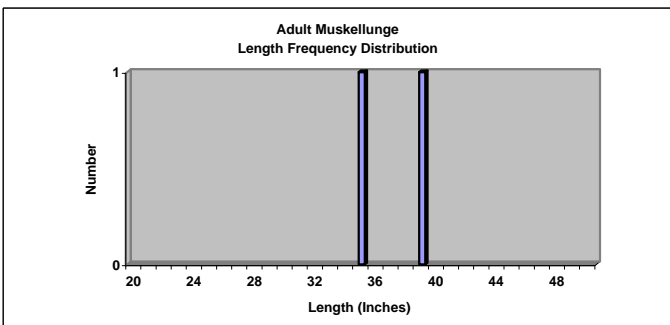

Other species sampled during this survey but not included in the report were lake sturgeon, bluegill, pumpkinseed, black crappie, yellow perch, rock bass, and white sucker.

We are also conducting a creel (angler harvest) survey on Little Yellow Lake this year. Creel clerk Abby Medis will count and interview anglers and examine their catch throughout the fishing season.
