



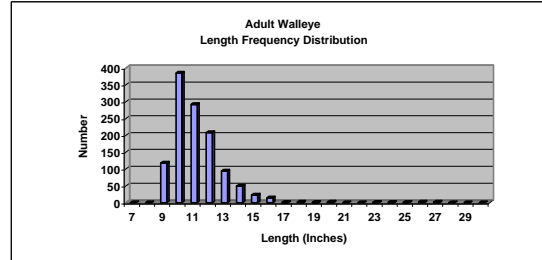
**WISCONSIN DNR
FISHERIES INFORMATION SHEET
PINE LAKE, IRON COUNTY, 2008**

The Department of Natural Resources conducted a fisheries assessment of Pine Lake, Iron County, from April 30, 2008 to May 05, 2008.

Pine Lake is a drainage lake in the Lake Superior basin. The walleye fishery is supported through natural reproduction. The population estimate for adult walleye was greater than lakes with similar characteristics.

Other Species

Some of the other species observed during this survey but not included in the report were muskellunge, smallmouth bass, bluegill, yellow perch, and white sucker.

We are also conducting a creel (angler harvest) survey on Pine Lake this year. Creel clerk Chuck Janov will count and interview anglers and examine their catch throughout the fishing season.
