Town 41 North, Range 7 East

- Section 3 – NWNW
- Section 4 – N1/2NW1/4; N1/2NE1/4
- Section 5 – N1/2NE1/4

Town 42 North, Range 7 East

- Section 32 – SESE
- Section 33 – SW1/4; SE1/4
- Section 34 – W1/2SW1/4

10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 295 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

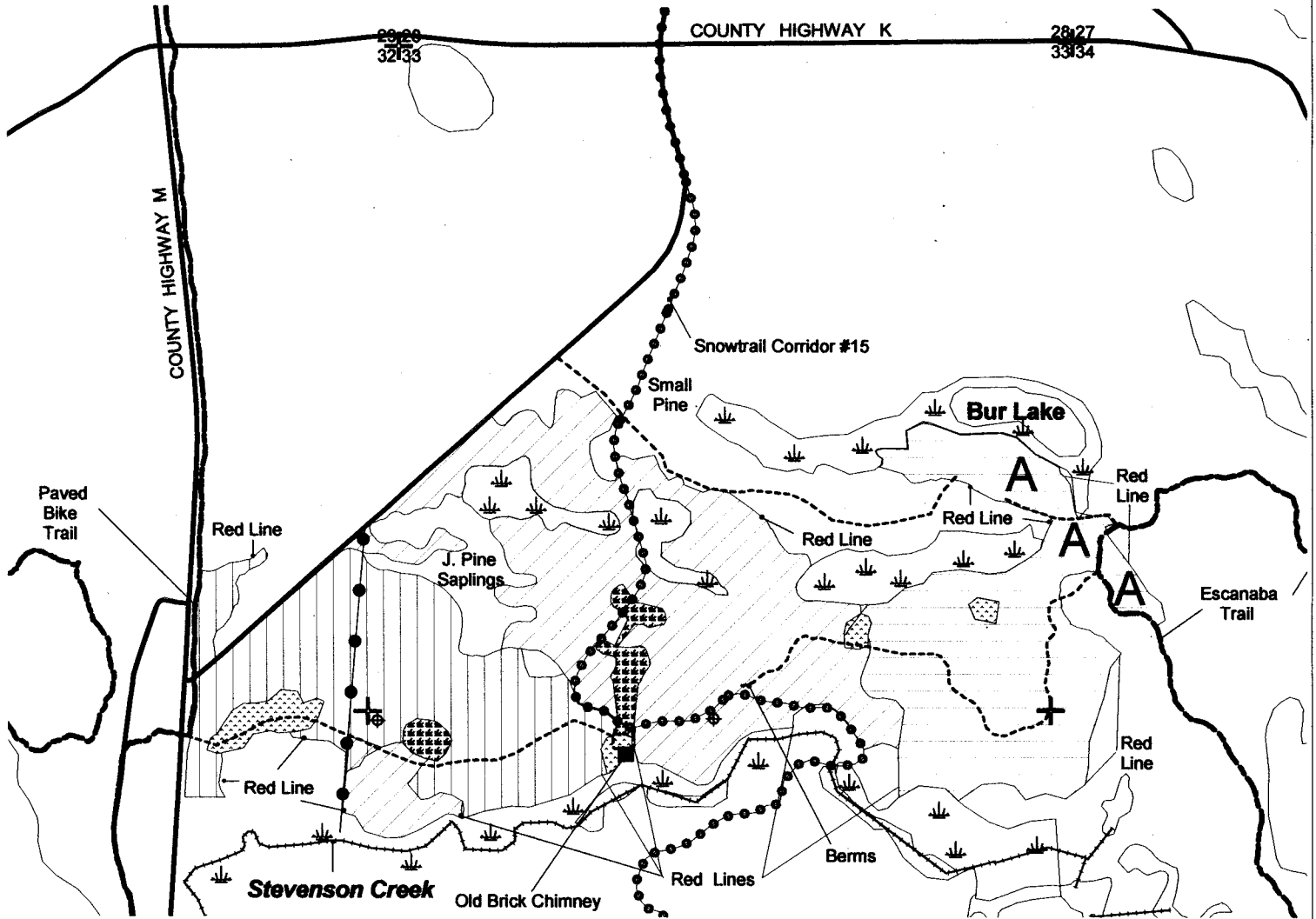

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in the low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.⁽⁹⁾
2. Harvesting activities in Zone A will be permitted from April 1 – December 1.⁽¹³⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of the paved bike trail and the Escanaba Trail must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line or in any open swamp. All trails must be kept open and free of debris at all times.⁽¹⁵⁾
4. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up. Decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail when not in use by snowmobiles. Hauling on the snowmobile trail will be allowed in predetermined locations and the trail will remain snow covered when hauling. The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.⁽¹⁷⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³²⁾
6. Ignore old green, yellow, orange, and red paint marks not identified on the timber sale map.⁽³⁴⁾

- Red Pine Area (127 Acres): Cut all scotch pine, jack pine, aspen, white birch, maple, oak, and all trees with orange paint.
- Jack Pine Area (84 Acres): Same prescription as above.
- Oak Regeneration Area (84 Acres): Cut all tree species except cut only red and white pine marked with orange paint. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.

Note: All harvesting within 1/4 mile of the Escanaba Trail (Zone A) is only permitted April 1 - Dec. 1
