All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

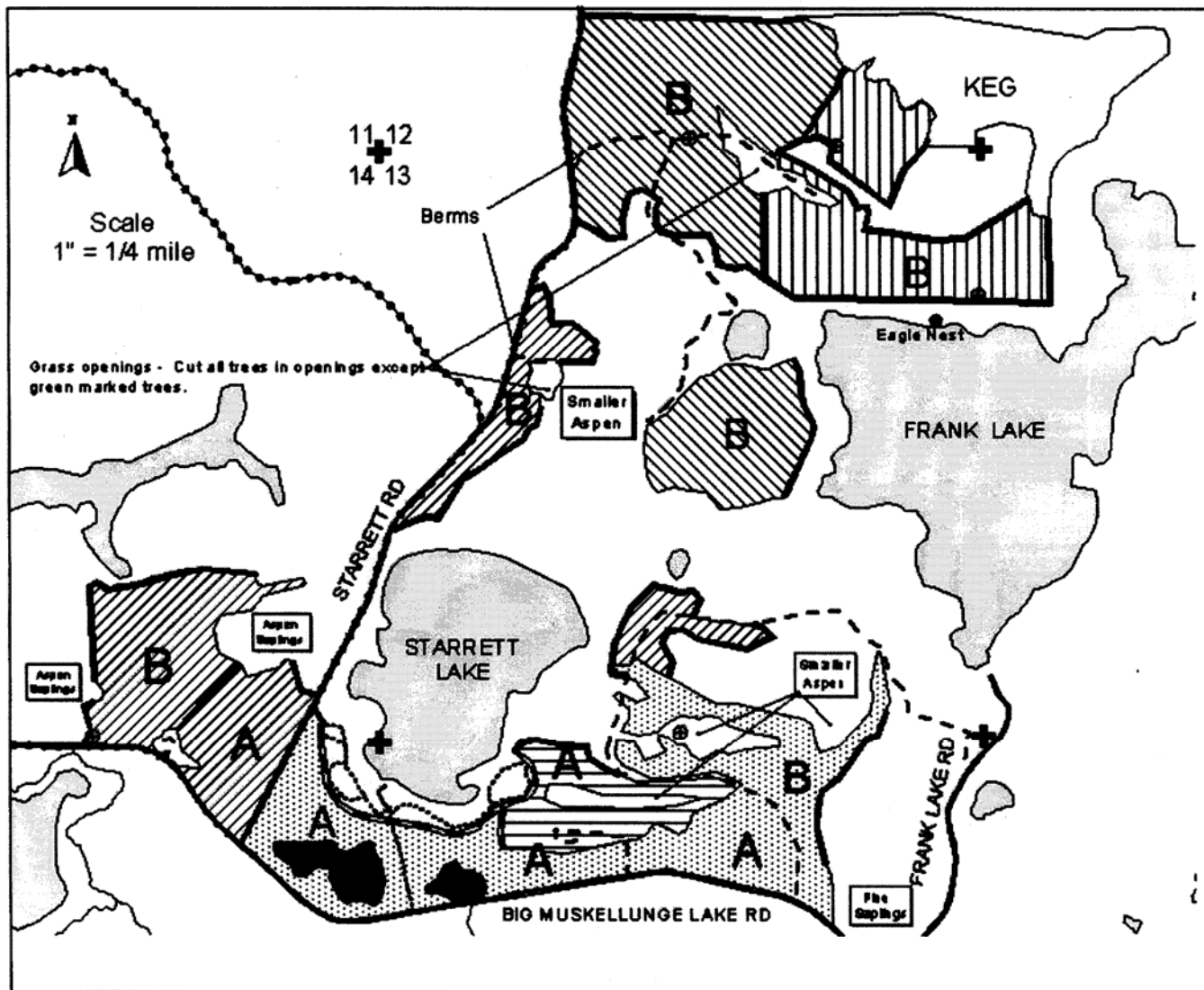

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in the low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions. ⁽⁹⁾
2. Harvesting activities will be allowed as follows: Zone A from September 15-May 15 Zone B – no restriction⁽¹³⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads and campground entrance road must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, yellow line, or in any open swamp. ⁽¹⁵⁾
4. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale zone start up. Snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. No decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail and the trail must remain snow covered when hauling. ⁽¹⁷⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year. ⁽³²⁾

- Red Oak Area (116 acres): Cut all trees except spruce. Cut only those red pine, white pine, and oak marked with orange paint.
- Pine Area (85 acres): Same prescription as red oak area; except within the main red pine plantation out all scrub oak. Also cut all pine rows designated with 3 spots of orange paint.
- Release Area (89 acres): Cut all trees except out only those red and white pine marked with orange.
- Northern Hardwood Area (62 acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, fir, ironwood, and orange marked trees.
- Leave Tree Area (23 acres): Cut all trees except do not out any red pine, white pine, or green marked trees.

DO NOT CUT ANY GREEN MARKED TREES WITHIN ENTIRE SALE AREA.
 All cutting in Zone A permitted between September 15-May 15 only.
 All cutting in Zone B permitted throughout the year.
