The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

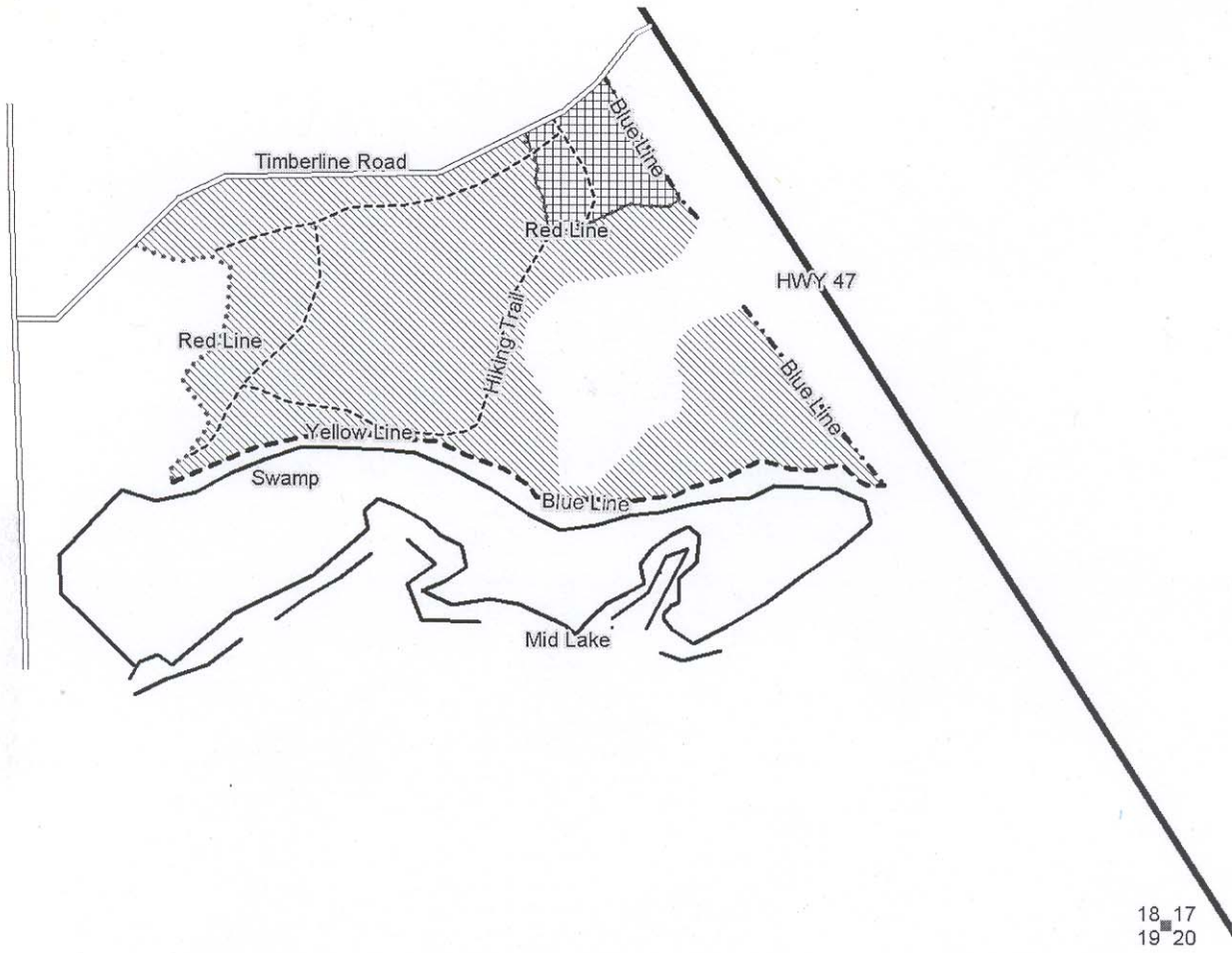









Special Conditions:

1. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, blue line, or in any open swamp.⁽¹⁶⁾
2. Landings and new road construction must be approved prior to construction.⁽¹⁸⁾
3. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³⁵⁾
4. Travel through the low ground area will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions. Possible rutting could happen if this is not followed.⁽³⁵⁾
5. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMP's) must be followed in areas adjacent to swamps and wetlands⁽¹⁸⁾
6. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees, including understory pine and oak, must be avoided.⁽³⁵⁾
