The cutting area is approximately 546 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Special Conditions:

1. Boulder Junction Gun Range: No harvest activity allowed within the range boundary, marked with blue paint, on Wednesdays or during the weekend. Slash within the former archery site must be treated. The sale administrator will show the site to the contractor when harvest starts.⁽³⁵⁾
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. ⁽⁹⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads must be lopped and/scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red or blue line, or in any open swamp. ⁽¹⁶⁾
4. All landings and any new roads must be approved by the timber sale administrator. ⁽¹⁸⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³⁵⁾
6. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. Snowmobile trails must be repaired to pre-harvest condition.⁽¹⁸⁾
