The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

²Volume includes 51% (Norway-black-white) spruce, 48% balsam fir and 1% tamarack.

³Volume includes 63% basswood, 31% white birch, and 6% maple.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.⁽⁹⁾
2. Zone A must be harvested during frozen ground conditions.⁽¹³⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, blue line, or in any open swamp.⁽¹⁶⁾
4. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up. The snowmobile trail must remain free of debris, snow covered, and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.⁽¹⁸⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³²⁾
6. Ignore old green and red paint marks not identified on the timber sale map.⁽³⁴⁾
