The cutting area is approximately 133 acres.

The contract period is 2 years. All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Special Conditions:

1. All pine products cut between June 1st. and September 1st. must be removed from the sale area within three weeks time of cutting. Pine products during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1st. of each year.⁽³⁵⁾
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.⁽⁹⁾
3. Cutting within Zone A will only be permitted during frozen ground conditions.⁽³⁵⁾
4. Cutting within Zone B will only be permitted during non-frozen ground conditions.⁽³⁵⁾
5. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.⁽¹⁶⁾
6. All landings and any new roads must be approved by the timber sale administer. ⁽¹⁷⁾
7. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided.
8. Equipment Restrictions: Skidding of forest product materials will be restricted to shortwood skidders only
9. No whole tree utilization permitted within Zone B. ⁽⁹⁾
