Oneida County

Town 36 North, Range 6 East

Section 21 – Gov. Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for the performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 122 acres.

The contract period is 1 year.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

¹ Aspen includes approximately 75% aspen, 15% birch, and 10% oak.

Special Conditions:

This is a **lump sum sale**. Two payments of ½ total bid value are allowed but must be paid prior to cutting in each zone (one payment for zone A and one payment for zone B). Either zone can be cut first.

All trees are to be pre-approved prior to cutting if not marked or designated to cut. Any unmarked trees cut, pushed over, or damaged shall be decked by the operator. These trees will be scaled and billed separate from (but in addition to) the lump sum bid. Any trees cut without approval will subject the contractor to penalties and fines.

Other Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. (9)
2. All landings require prior approval. (17)
3. All trails and roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition. (17)
4. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees, including understory pine regeneration, must be avoided.
5. No sale activities are permitted during the months of May and June. (17)
6. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed adjacent to the Tomahawk River.
 - A. No wheeled or tracked vehicles permitted within 50 feet of water's edge.
 - B. No landings or new skid roads permitted within 100' of water's edge.
 - C. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.
7. All roads must be returned to their original condition. (17)
8. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within 1 foot of the ground. (15)
