All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized

<sup>1</sup>Approximately 47% sugar maple, 25% red maple, 21% white birch, 6% basswood, and 1% ironwood.

<sup>2</sup>Approximately 98% red oak, and 2% scrub oak.

<sup>3</sup>Approximately 98% balsam fir, 2% spruce.

<sup>4</sup>Approximately 60% red maple, 25% basswood, and 15% white birch.

**Special Conditions:**

- Each block (identified as A & B, must be cut separately and completed before beginning on the next block. All species within each block must be cut concurrently before moving into the other block.<sup>(13)</sup>
- Equipment Restrictions: Skidding of forest product materials will be restricted to shortwood skidders only.<sup>(13)</sup>
- Slash within 50' of Vandercook road must be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind tree line concurrent with cutting.<sup>(15)</sup>
- Snowmobile trails including Vandercook road must remain snow covered (see timber sale map).
- Decking will be permitted along snowmobile trails only when trails are not in use and must be removed before the start of each new snow season (Trails normally open December 10<sup>th</sup>). Logging slash must be removed from within trails. All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions before the start of each new season.<sup>(17)</sup>
- No entry into the reserve area (see timber sale map) shall occur from Feb.15<sup>th</sup> through July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up.<sup>(17)</sup>
- All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.<sup>(32)</sup>
- Whole tree harvesting WILL NOT be permitted on this sale.<sup>(9)</sup>
- Ignore old red paint marks within the Oak/White Birch/Aspen harvest area. Cutting of forest products is limited to non-frozen soil conditions only.

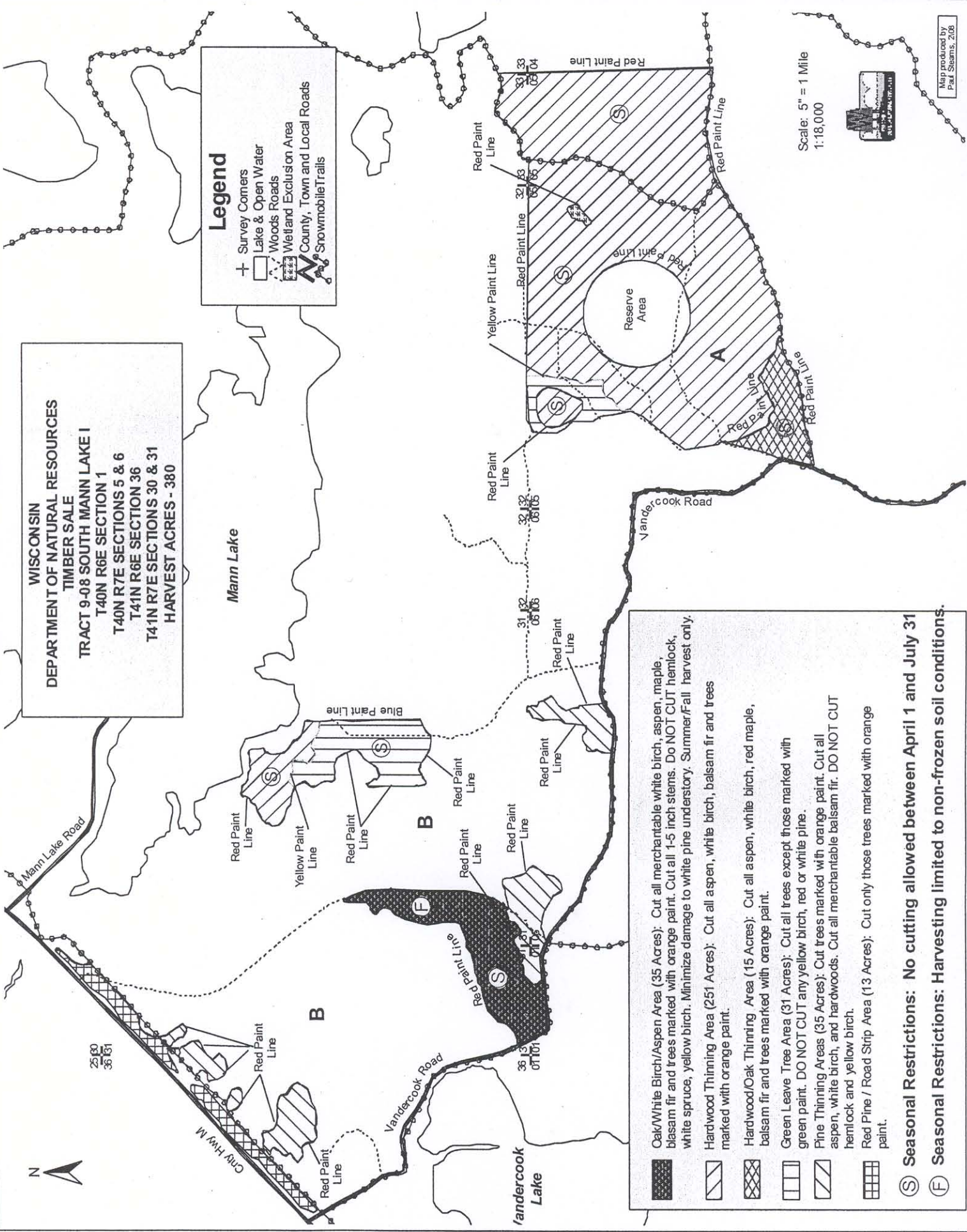

**○ Seasonal Restrictions: No cutting allowed between April 1 and July 31**  
**ⓕ Seasonal Restrictions: Harvesting limited to non-frozen soil conditions.**

- Oak/White Birch/Aspen Area (35 Acres): Cut all merchantable white birch, aspen, maple, balsam fir and trees marked with orange paint. Cut all 1-5 inch stems. Do NOT CUT hemlock, white spruce, yellow birch. Minimize damage to white pine understory. Summer/Fall harvest only.
- Hardwood Thinning Area (251 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir and trees marked with orange paint.
- Hardwood/Oak Thinning Area (15 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, red maple, balsam fir and trees marked with orange paint.
- Green Leave Tree Area (31 Acres): Cut all trees except those marked with green paint. DO NOT CUT any yellow birch, red or white pine.
- Pine Thinning Areas (35 Acres): Cut trees marked with orange paint. Cut all aspen, white birch, and hardwoods. Cut all merchantable balsam fir. DO NOT CUT hemlock and yellow birch.
- Red Pine / Road Strip Area (13 Acres): Cut only those trees marked with orange paint.
