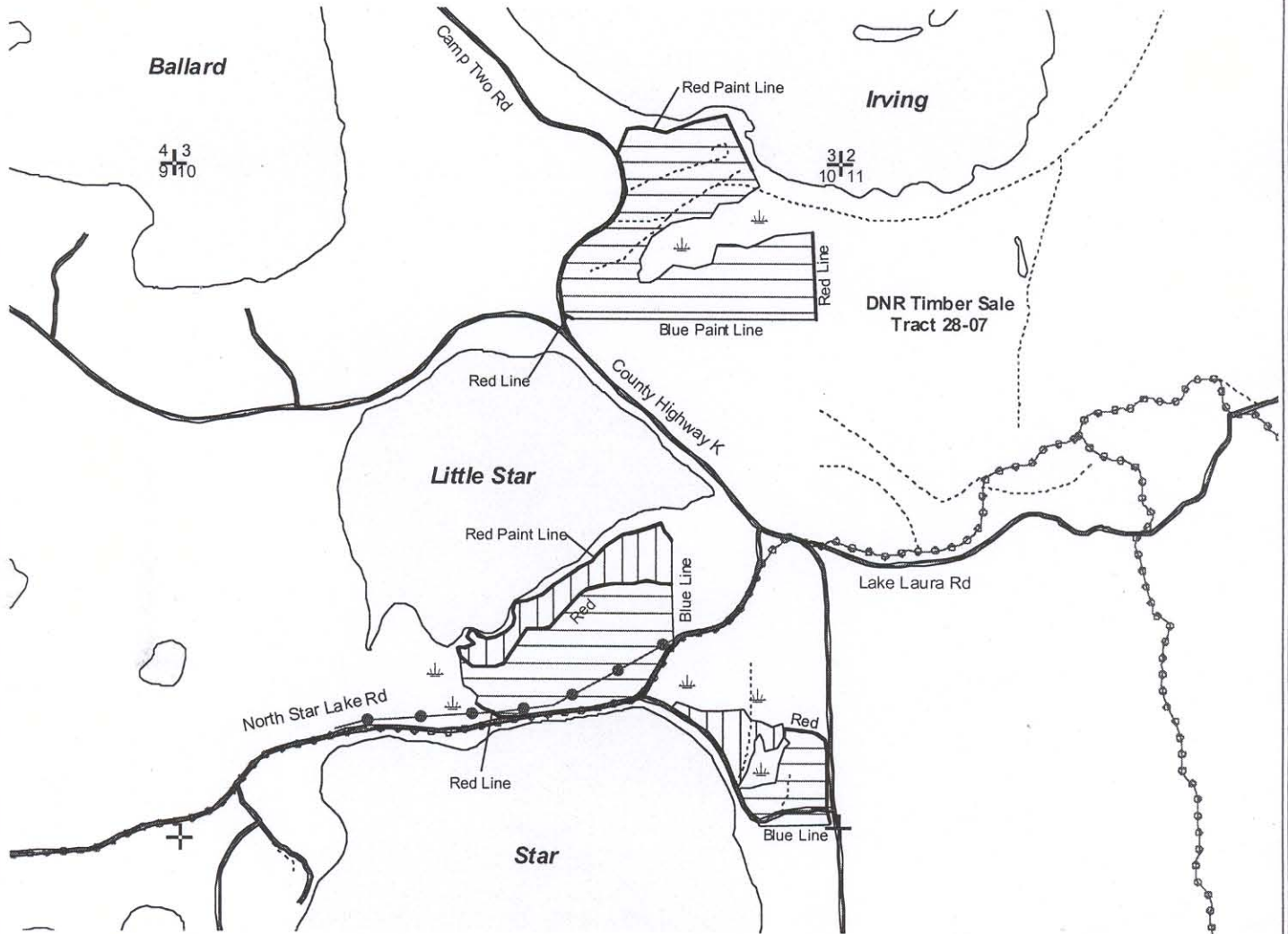




Special Conditions:

- 1) No cutting will be permitted between April 1 and July 31 in the Northern Hardwood area.<sup>(13)</sup>
- 2) Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.<sup>(9)</sup>
- 3) Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas or across blue paint lines.<sup>(16)</sup>
- 4) Slash within aesthetic zones must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.<sup>(16)</sup>
- 5) Landings will not be permitted within the aesthetic zones or within 100 feet of town roads.<sup>(18)</sup>
- 6) Decking will not be permitted within the aesthetic zones or within 100 feet of town roads.<sup>(18)</sup>
- 7) All pine products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.<sup>(35)</sup>
- 8) Pole skidding WILL NOT be allowed within the selection areas.<sup>(9)</sup>








 Aspen Regeneration Area (16 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, scotch pine and balsam fir with at least one merchantable stick. Cut all orange marked trees. Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.
