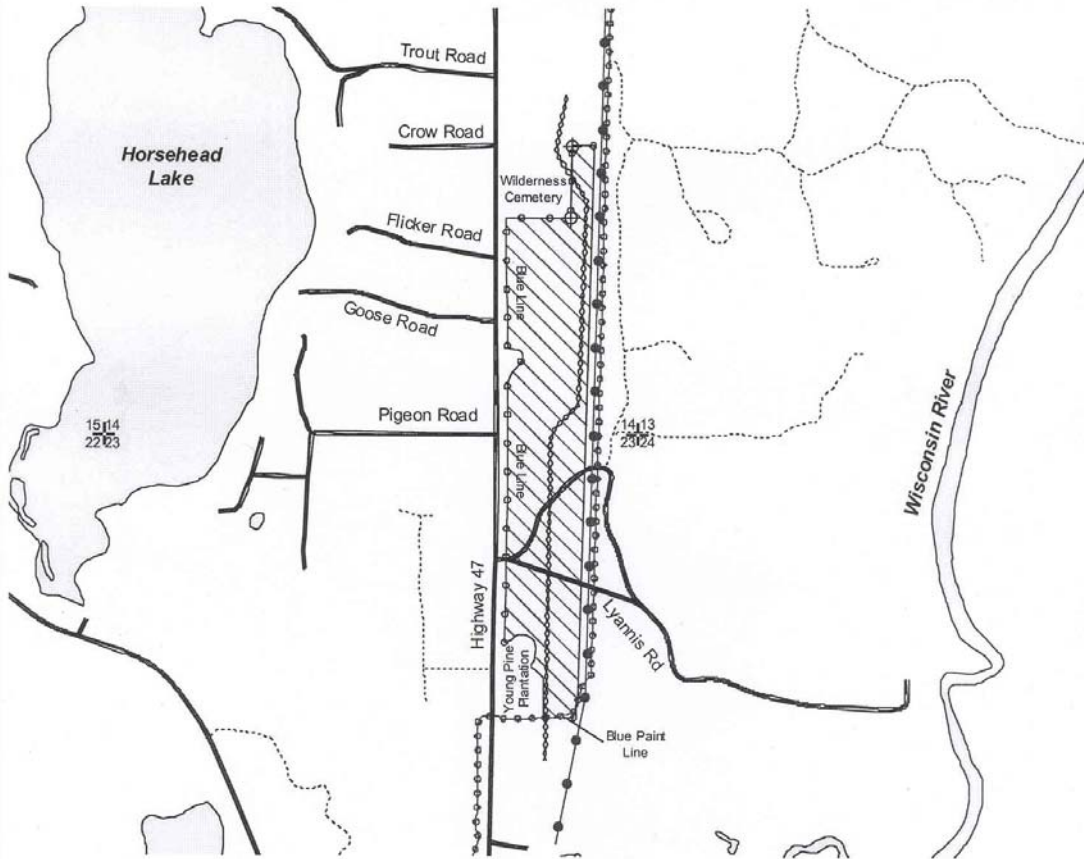

Special Conditions:

1. Absolutely no damage to Lyannis Road or harm to any of the residual trees or seedling/saplings.<sup>(18)</sup>
2. NO TREES WILL BE CUT AND FALLEN INTO THE WILDERNESS REST CEMETARY.<sup>(35)</sup>
3. Trees that are cut into the DOT right-of-way and the high power line right-of-way must be pulled back into the sale area for slashing and bucking.<sup>(16)</sup>
4. Slash will be kept to two feet or less lopped and scattered throughout the rest of the sale. Slash adjacent to the cemetery and Lyannis Rd. is to be one foot or less. The same applies for all adjacent landowner properties.<sup>(16)</sup>
5. The sale can be accessed on the far south end by using the snowmobile trail.<sup>(18)</sup>
6. The snowmobile trail must be maintained in the original presale condition after the harvest.<sup>(18)</sup>
7. Trails will remain open and kept free of hazards at all times during the timber harvest. When the harvest is occurring, proper "Logging Ahead" signs will be placed on all of the trails that the snowmobiles use for the public's safety.<sup>(18)</sup>
8. There are no seasonal restrictions on logging operations during the contract period.<sup>(9)</sup>
