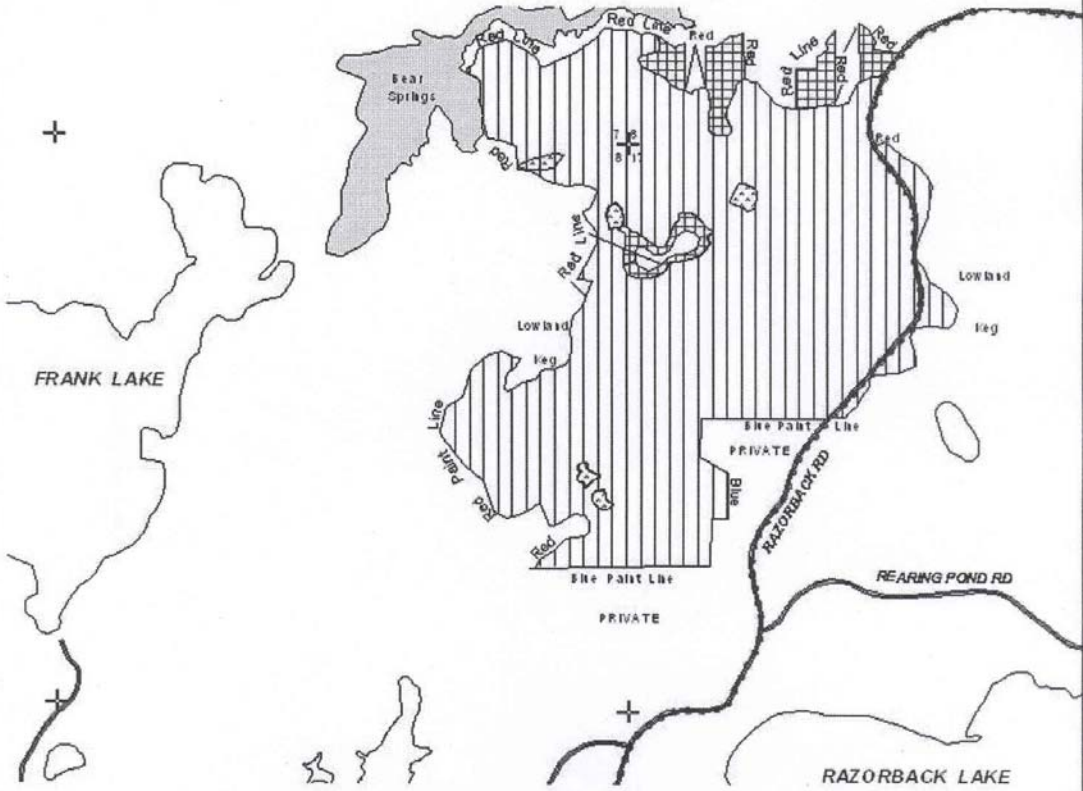

Special Conditions:



1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.<sup>(9)</sup>
2. Slash within 50 feet of the Town road must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red or blue line.<sup>(16)</sup>
3. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up. The snowmobile trail must remain free of debris, snow covered during winter, and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.<sup>(18)</sup>
4. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year. <sup>(35)</sup>
