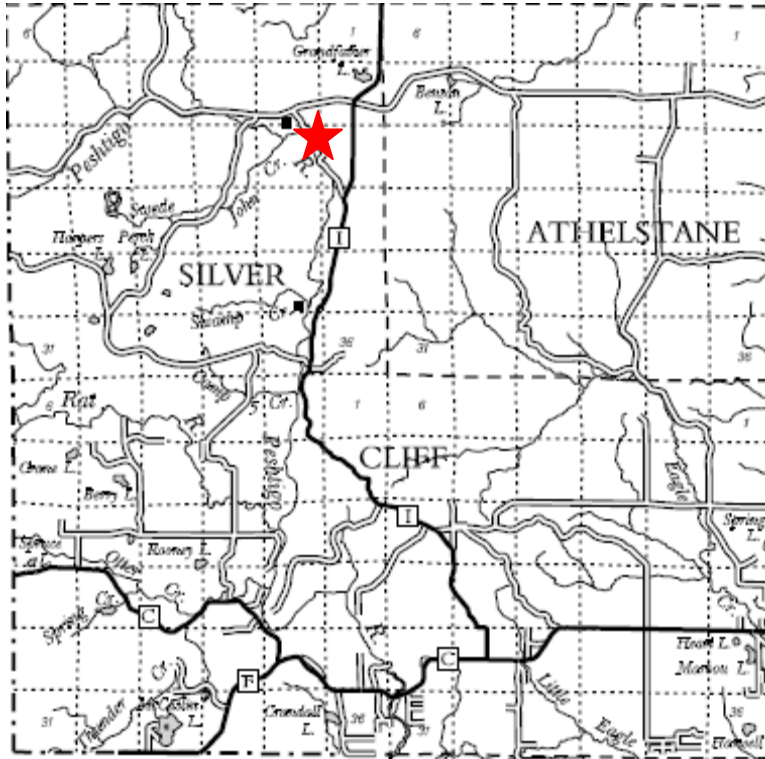

Directions:

GOODMAN PARK is located on the Peshtigo River in the Town of Silver Cliff. From Highway 32 in Wabeno, go east on County Highway C for about 20 miles, then go north 9 miles on County Highway I (also known as Parkway Road), then proceed northwest 2 miles on Goodman Park Road. The meeting is in the large lodge next to the river.
