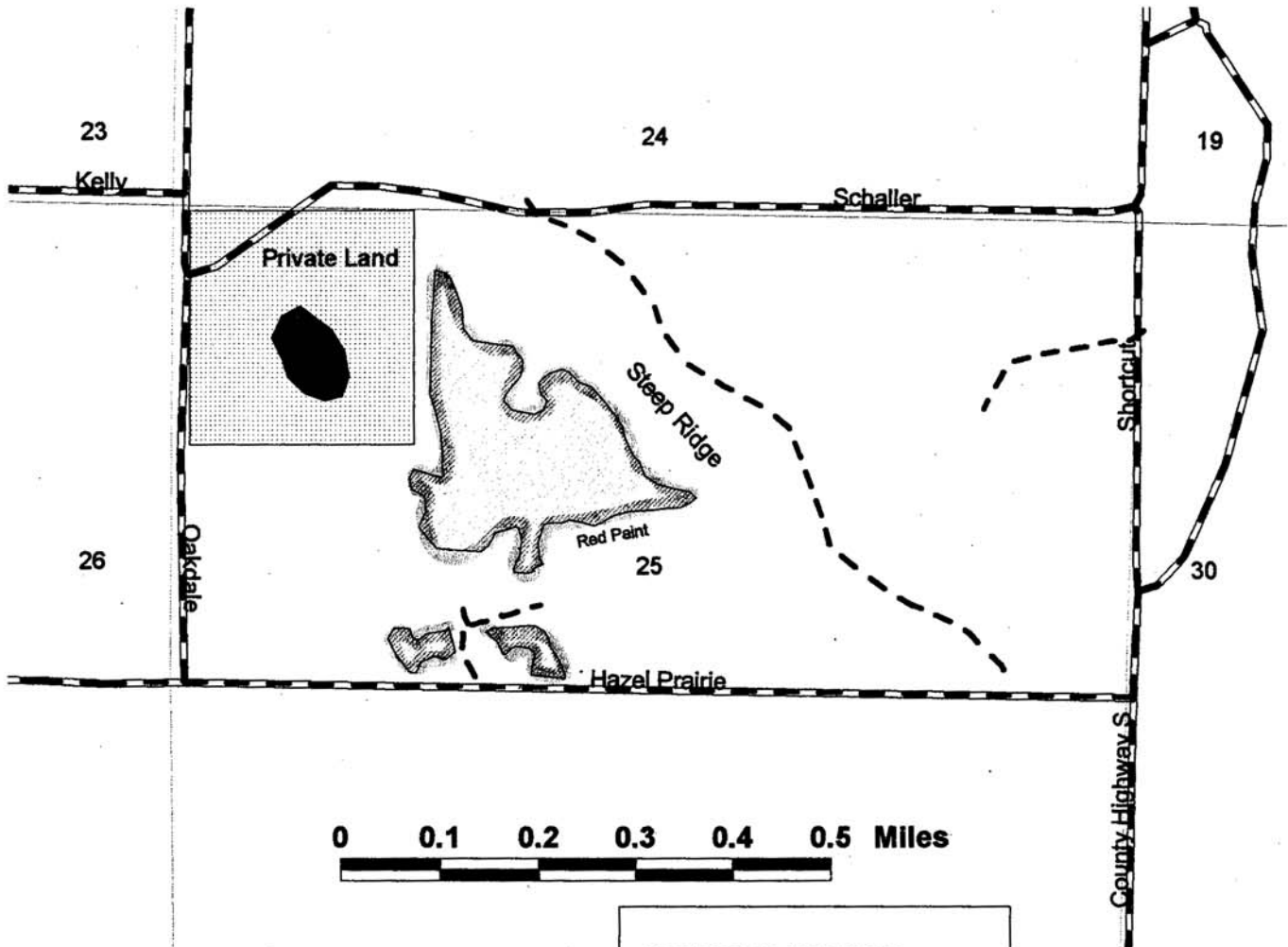

ESTIMATED VOLUMES	
Birch:	370 cords
Mixed Hdwd:	120 cords
Red Oak:	115 cords
Aspen:	60 cords

Mixed Hdwd volume is primarily maple.  
A considerable volume of red oak will meet or exceed a 8 inch diameter sawbolt spec.

- 1) Cut all Birch, Oak, Aspen, and Maple 6 inches DBH and above. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.
- 2) Utilize all trees that contain one or more 100 inch sticks to a 4 inch minimum top diameter.
- 3) New road and landing construction must be approved by BRSF staff before construction.
- 4) Do not cut or damage any residual trees or any trees marked with green paint.
- 5) Sale has no seasonal restrictions, however no rutting will be allowed. The town of Highland may seasonally limit use of Hazel Prairie road.
- 6) Contract length shall be 2 years.
- 7) Minimum bid for this sale is \$14,700.
