



Area A: Cut all jack pine, oak, aspen, and all marked red pine.

Area B: Cut all trees marked with orange paint.

Area C: Cut all red pine.

Area D: Cut every other row of trees.

Area E: Cut all trees over 2 inches DBH.

Estimated Volumes To Be Removed

Red Pine:	850 cords
Jack Pine:	375 cords
Aspen:	140 cords
White Pine:	45 cords
Spruce:	25 cords
Scrub Oak:	25 cords

NOTE!

A considerable volume of red pine, white pine, and spruce will meet or exceed a 9 inch diameter sawbolt specification.

- 1) Cut and utilize all designated trees containing one or more 100 inch sticks to a 4 inch top minimum diameter.
- 2) Existing roads and landings will be utilized. Any new construction to be approved by BRSF representative before construction.
- 3) Slash shall be evenly scattered and lying within 2 feet of the ground across sale area upon conclusion of cutting activity. Trees must be cut to product length at the stump.
- 4) No equipment operation within 50 feet of the Eau Claire River unless on established roadway.
- 5) Between May 15 and Aug 15 all cut products shall be removed from site within 2 weeks of cutting to prevent bark beetle infestations.
- 6) Gordon Correctional officials shall be contacted prior to entering property for any purpose. (715- 376-2680)
- 7) Contract length shall be 2 years. Minimum bid for this sale is \$49,300.
