10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 437 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

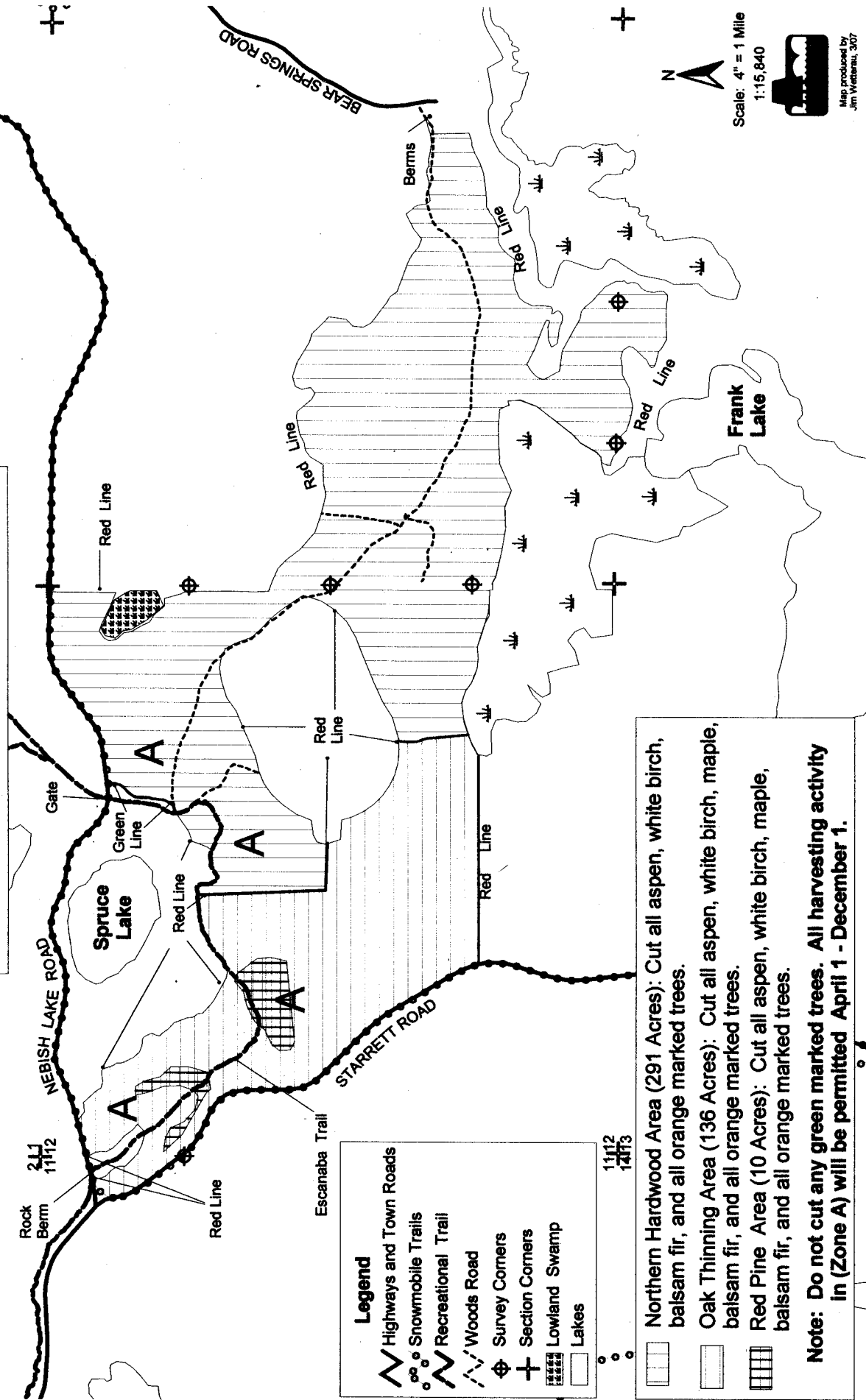
¹Volume includes 44% white birch, 38% sugar maple, 8% oak, 7% red maple, and 3% ironwood.

²Volume includes 5% red maple.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in the low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.⁽⁹⁾
2. Harvesting activities in Zone A, that area within ¼ mile of the Escanaba Trail, will be permitted from April 1 – December 1.⁽¹³⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads and the Escanaba Trail must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, green line, or in any open swamp. All trails must be kept open and free of debris at all times.⁽¹⁵⁾
4. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale start up. Use of the Escanaba Trail for decking, skidding, and hauling will be limited to predetermined locations prior to sale start up. The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. No decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail and the trail must remain snow covered when hauling.⁽¹⁷⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year.⁽³²⁾

- Northern Hardwood Area (291 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, and all orange marked trees.
- Oak Thinning Area (136 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir, and all orange marked trees.
- Red Pine Area (10 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir, and all orange marked trees.

Note: Do not cut any green marked trees. All harvesting activity in (Zone A) will be permitted April 1 - December 1.
