Section 14 – NWNE, SWNE, NENW, NWNW

10% of the total sale bid value will be required for a bid bond.

The harvest area is approximately 60 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

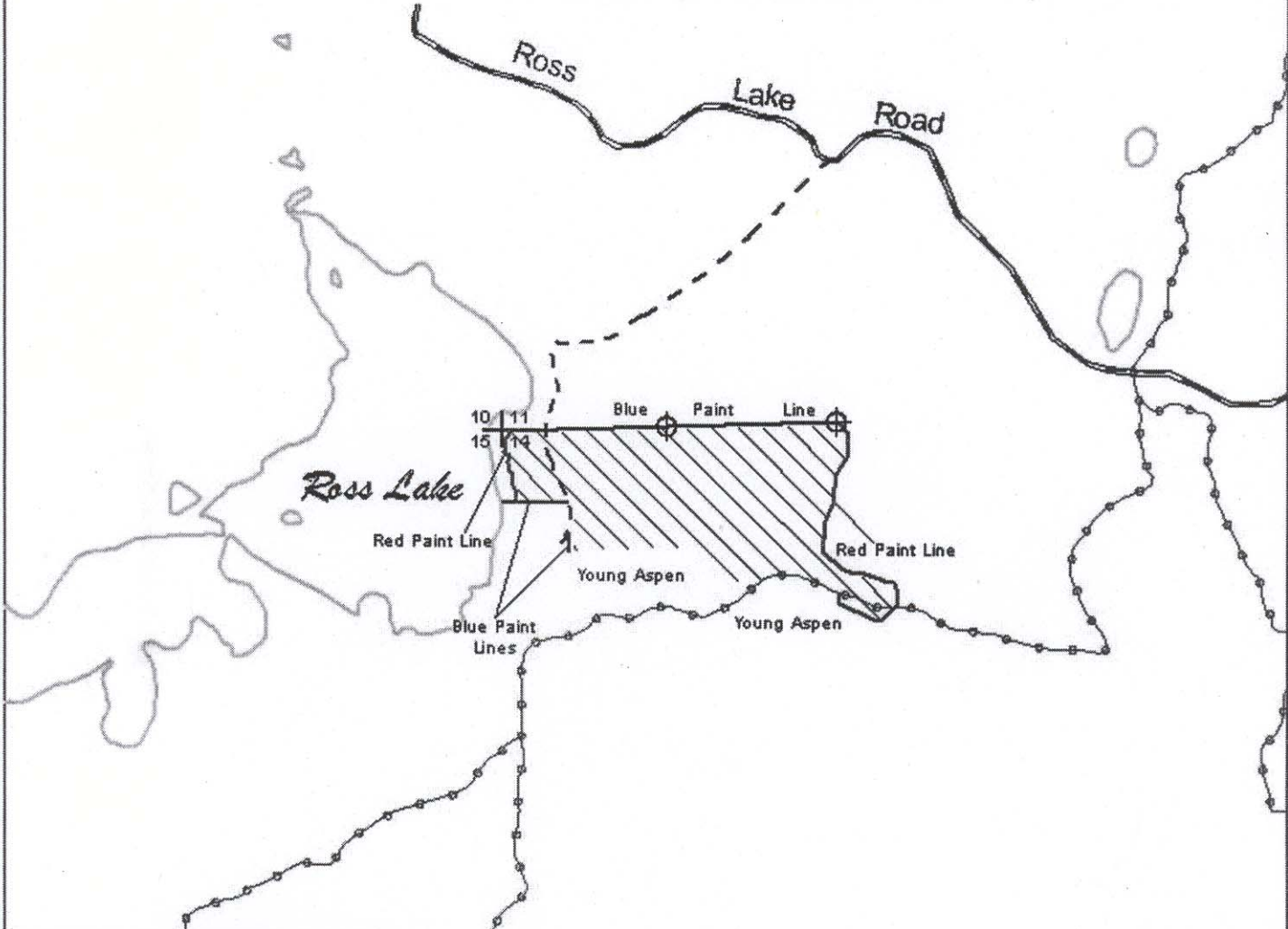



Special Conditions


1. No slash across sale boundary lines.⁽¹⁵⁾
2. Landings and any new road locations must be approved prior to construction.⁽¹⁷⁾
3. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. Decking wood will be permitted along the snowmobile trail only when the trail is not in use. Wood decked on the snowmobile trails must be removed before the start of the snowmobile season. All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest condition before the start of the snow season.⁽¹⁷⁾
4. To promote maximum benefit to the environment, the health and welfare of our logging contractors, and to adhere to requirements of forest certification standards, effective 1/1/2006 the Department of Natural Resources will require training of its logging contractors. Successful purchasers of DNR stumpage will need to ensure that the logging contractor actually engaged in performance of the contract complies with the Wisconsin Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) Training Standard as adopted by the Wisconsin SFI Implementation Committee (SIC). Criteria for the standard can be found at the website www.fistausa.org/sfi_standards or by contacting the Forest Industry Safety & Training Alliance (FISTA). Documentation confirming completion of the training standard will be required prior to starting sale.
