The cutting area is approximately 164 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

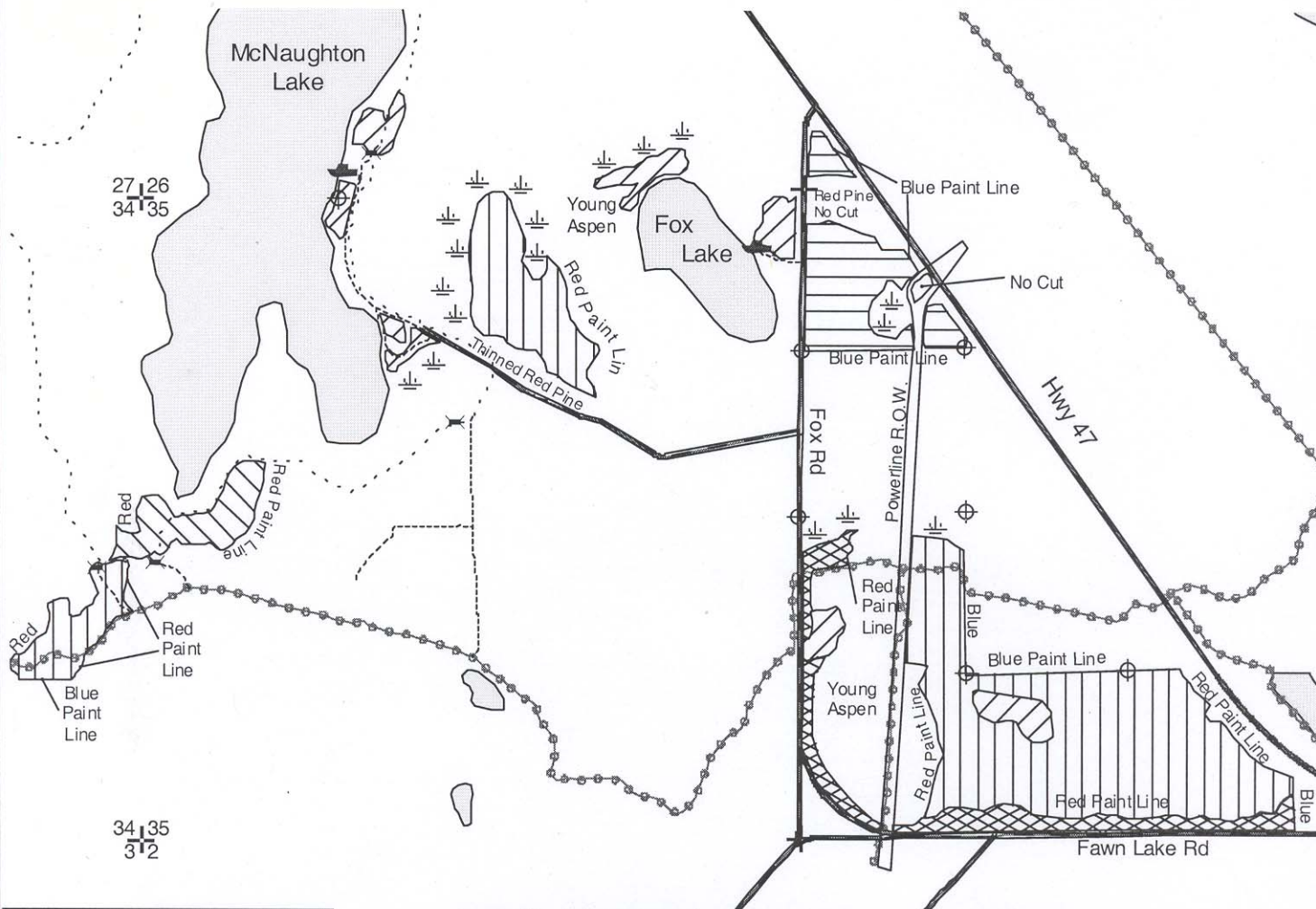
¹Approximately 80% soft maple and 20% white birch.

²Approximately 90% jack pine, 5% spruce, 4% white pine and 1% balsam fir.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.⁽⁹⁾
2. Slash within 50' of Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.⁽¹⁵⁾
3. Decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail only when the trail is not in use. Wood decked on the snowmobile trail must be removed before the start of each snowmobile season (Trails normally open December 10th). All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions before the start of each snow season.⁽¹⁷⁾

- Aspen/Oak (101 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, oak, balsam fir and jack pine not marked with green paint. Cut only those red pine and white pine marked with orange paint. All 1-5" aspen and maple must be cut concurrently with the harvest.
- Highway Road Zone (19 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir, and jack pine. Cut only those red pine, white pine, spruce, and oak which are marked with orange paint.
- Red Pine Plantation (18 Acres): Only cut those trees marked with orange paint.
- Fawn Lake Road Zone (16 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, and jack pine. Cut only those red pine, white pine, oak, and maple which are marked with orange paint. Do not cut 1-5" trees.
- Lake Zone (10 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir, and jack pine. Cut only those red pine, white pine, spruce, and oak marked with orange paint. No activity allowed during the ski season.
