The cutting area is approximately 269 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

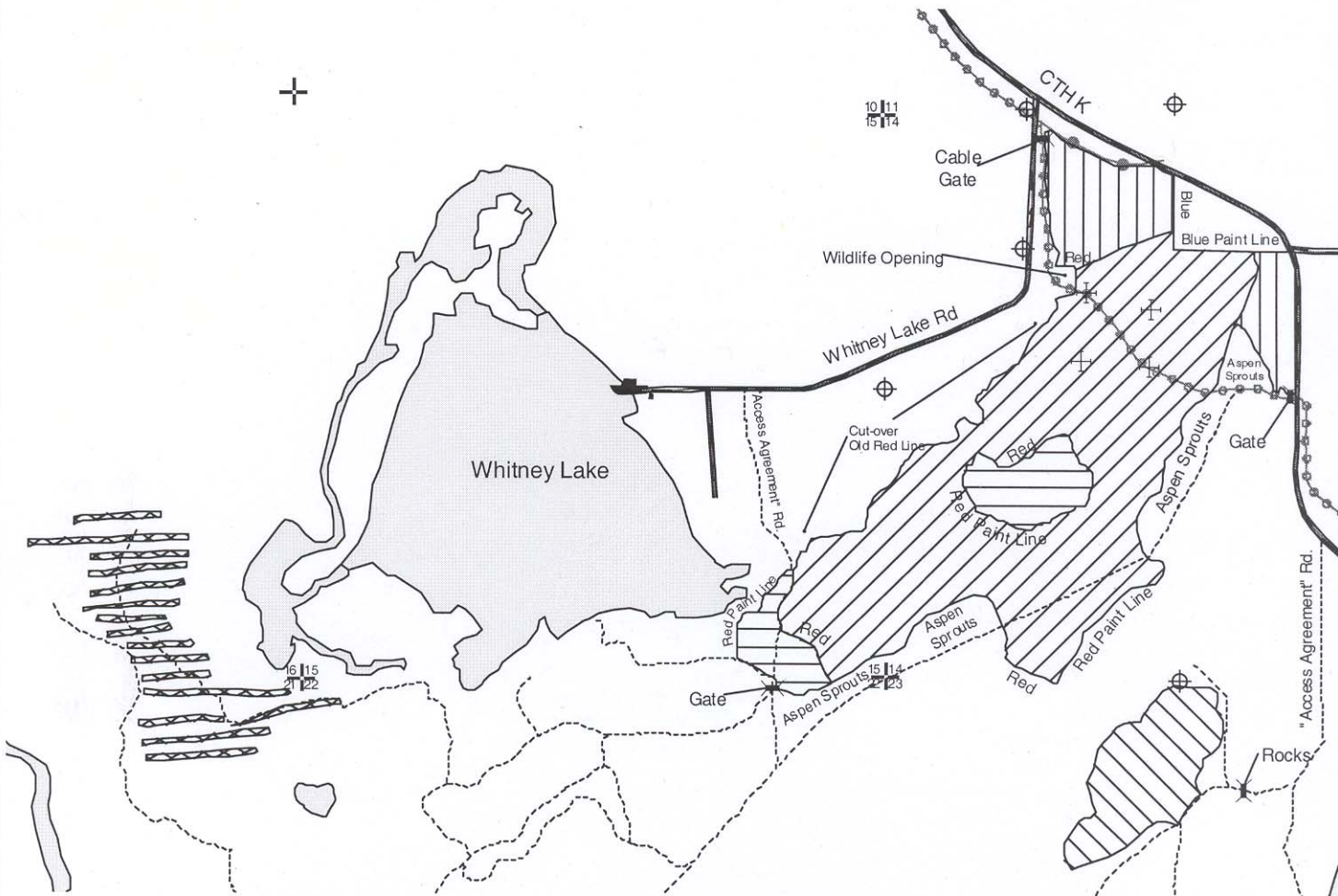

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.⁽⁹⁾
2. Slash within 50' of Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.⁽¹⁶⁾
3. Decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail only when the trail is not in use. Wood decked on the snowmobile trail must be removed before the start of each snowmobile season (Trails normally open December 10th). All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions before the start of each snow season.⁽¹⁸⁾
4. "Access Agreement" roads, as indicated on the map, must remain open and passable by vehicle traffic at all times and repaired to pre-harvest conditions if damaged.⁽¹⁸⁾

Oak/Hardwood Ridge (168 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir, and ironwood. Cut only those oak, red pine, and white pine marked with orange.



Aspen Areas (32 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple, balsam fir, and ironwood. Cut only those oak, red pine, and white pine marked with orange. All 1-5" aspen must be cut concurrently with harvest.



Oak/Pine Shelterwood (29 Acres): Cut only those trees marked with orange paint.



Marked Hardwood/Oak (24 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir and ironwood. Cut only those oak, maple, red pine, and white pine marked with orange paint.



Birch Regen Strips (16 Acres): Cut all trees, including 1-5" diameter stems, 50-feet south of past cut strip or half the distance to next cut strip, whichever is less. No skidding access allowed in past cut strips.
