The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Harvesting in the low ground areas will only be allowed during dry or frozen ground conditions.⁽⁹⁾
2. Harvesting activities will be allowed as follows: Zone A from September 15-May 15⁽¹³⁾
3. Slash within 50 feet of all Town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrent with cutting. No tops or slash allowed across any red line, blue line, or in any open swamp.⁽¹⁶⁾
4. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved prior to sale zone start up. Snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered, and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.⁽¹⁷⁾
5. All conifer products cut between June 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Conifer products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1 of each year. ⁽³²⁾

-  Orange Marked Area (62 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir and all orange marked trees. Leave all snags uncut. Do NOT cut any green marked trees.
-  Green Marked Area (72 Acres): Cut all trees, except cut only those red and white pine marked with orange paint. Do NOT cut any green marked trees.
-  Aspen Regeneration Area (51 Acres): Same prescription as Green Marked Area. Note the aspen maintenance required south of Snyder Road.
-  Red Pine Thinning (3 Acres): Same prescription as orange marked area.
