Town 43 North, Range 5 East

Section 36 – E1/2 NE1/4, E1/2 SE1/4

10% of the total sale bid value will be required as bid bond.

The cutting area is approximately 273 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

1. Approximately 75% white birch, 20% soft maple, 5% hard maple.

2. Approximately 52% jack pine, 48% red pine.

3. Approximately 82% balsam fir and 18% white pine.

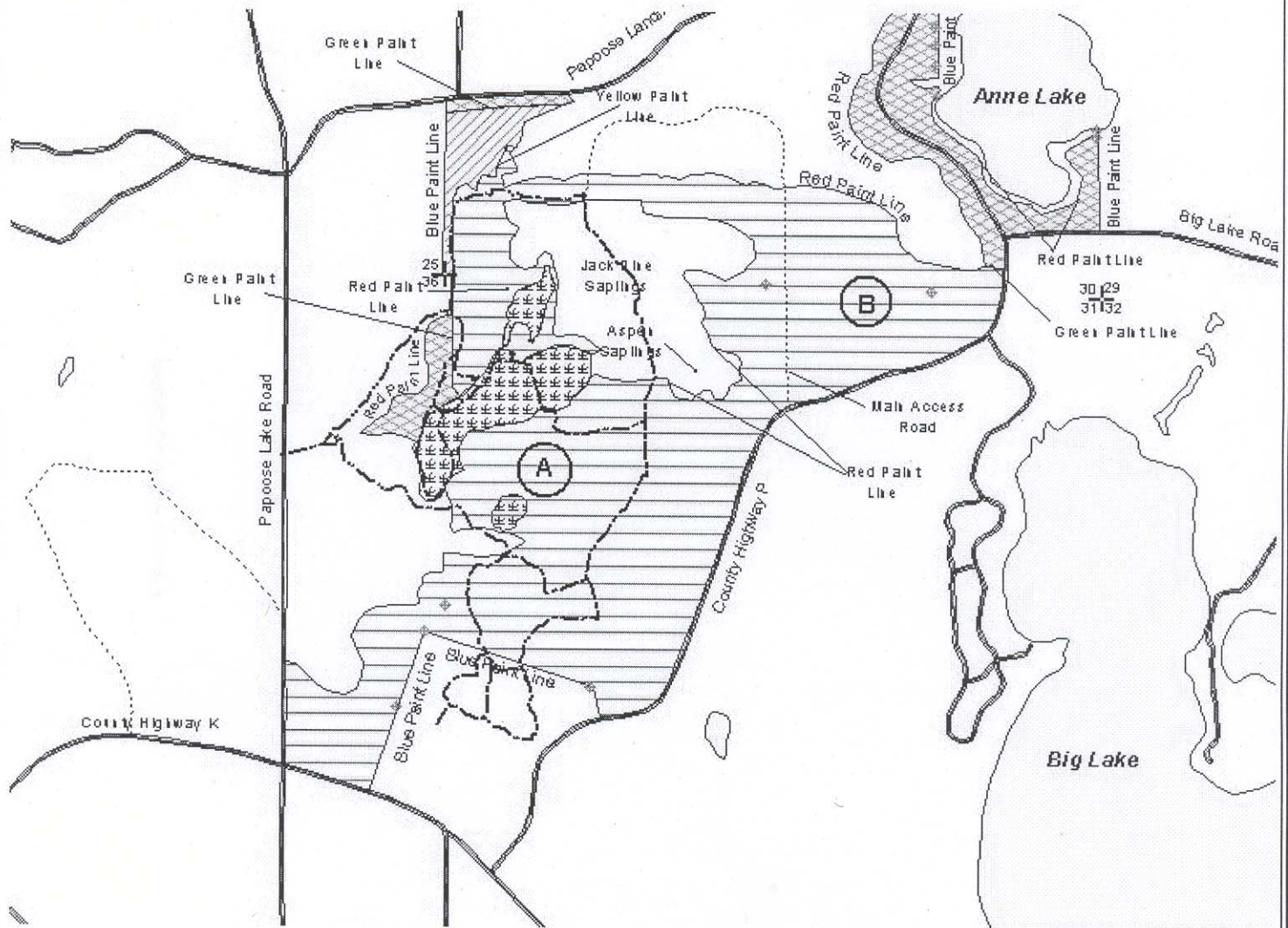
The sale area has been divided into two harvesting zones, A and B. Zone A lies west of the main access road and has seasonal restrictions in place to minimize impacts with the ski trail users.

This zone can only be harvested during a non ski season; the administering forester will decide the dates based on current snow and use information. Zone B lies east of the main access road and has no seasonal harvesting restrictions unless excessive damage is being caused to the site due to soil condition.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.<sup>(9)</sup>
2. Slash within 50' of recreational trails, Town, and county roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.<sup>(16)</sup>
3. Decking will be permitted along the ski trails only when the trail is not in use. Wood decked on the ski trails must be removed before the start of each ski season. All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions before the start of each snow season.<sup>(18)</sup>
4. Harvesting in proximity to the ski trail system (Zone A) can only take place during a non ski season. Harvesting other areas of the sale away from the trail system (Zone B) is permitted during any season which does not cause excessive damage to the residual stand.<sup>(13)</sup>
5. Landing sites and new haul roads need to be approved by the forester during the pre sale meeting with the logging contractor or as need arises.<sup>(18)</sup>

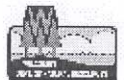

- Aesthetic Zones - Green Marked Areas (37 Acres): Cut all merchantable white birch and jack pine except those mark with green paint. Cut all aspen with at least 3 sticks. Cut all balsam fir with at least 3 sticks. DO NOT CUT the following maple, basswood, yellow birch, oak, spruce and white pine. DO NOT CUT any 1 to 5 inch trees and trees marked with green paint.
- Aspen Regeneration (9 Acres): Cut all merchantable trees except pine. Cut only those pine marked with orange paint. DO NOT CUT any 1 to 5 inch trees and trees marked with green paint.
- Red Pine Plantation (227 Acres): Cut all merchantable maple, white birch, jack pine and trees marked with orange paint. Cut all aspen with at least 3 sticks. Cut all balsam fir down to 1-stick. DO NOT CUT spruce and trees marked with green paint.
