The cutting area is approximately 268 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

¹Approximately 50% hard maple, 30% soft maple, 15% white birch, 3% ash, 2% yellow birch and less than 1% ironwood.

²Approximately 70% white pine, 25% balsam fir, and 5% red pine.

³Approximately 55% hard maple, 15% soft maple, 15% ash, and 15% yellow birch.

⁴Approximately 95% white pine and 5% red pine.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.⁽⁹⁾
2. Slash within 50' of Town roads or designated ski trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.⁽¹⁵⁾
3. All use of the ski trail for harvesting purposes will be at the discretion of the administering forester. Decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail and ski trails only when the trails are not in use. Wood decked on the snowmobile trail must be removed before the start of each snowmobile season (Trails normally open December 10th). All trails must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions before the start of each snow season.⁽¹⁷⁾
4. Seasonal cutting restrictions for each unit are as indicated on map.

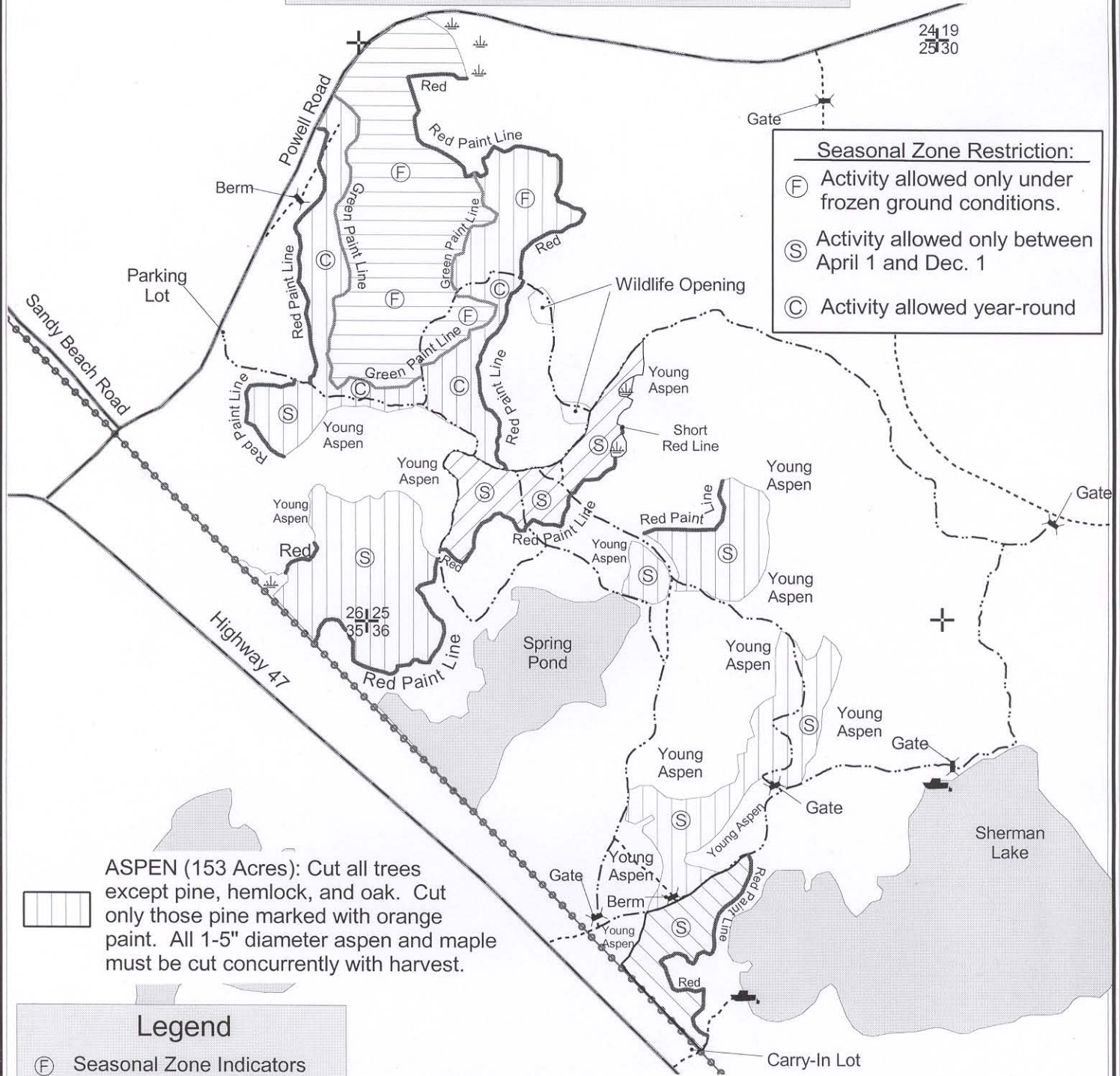

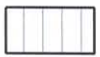
(F) Activity allowed only under frozen ground conditions.

ASPEN (153 Acres): Cut all trees except pine, hemlock, and oak. Cut only those pine marked with orange paint. All 1-5" diameter aspen and maple must be cut concurrently with harvest.

MARKED HARDWOOD (75 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, and trees marked with orange.



ASPEN/PINE (23 Acres): Cut all trees except hemlock and oak. All 1-5" diameter aspen and maple must be cut concurrently with harvest.



LAKE ZONE (17 Acres): Cut only aspen, white birch and balsam fir. No cutting of 1-5" diameter maple.
