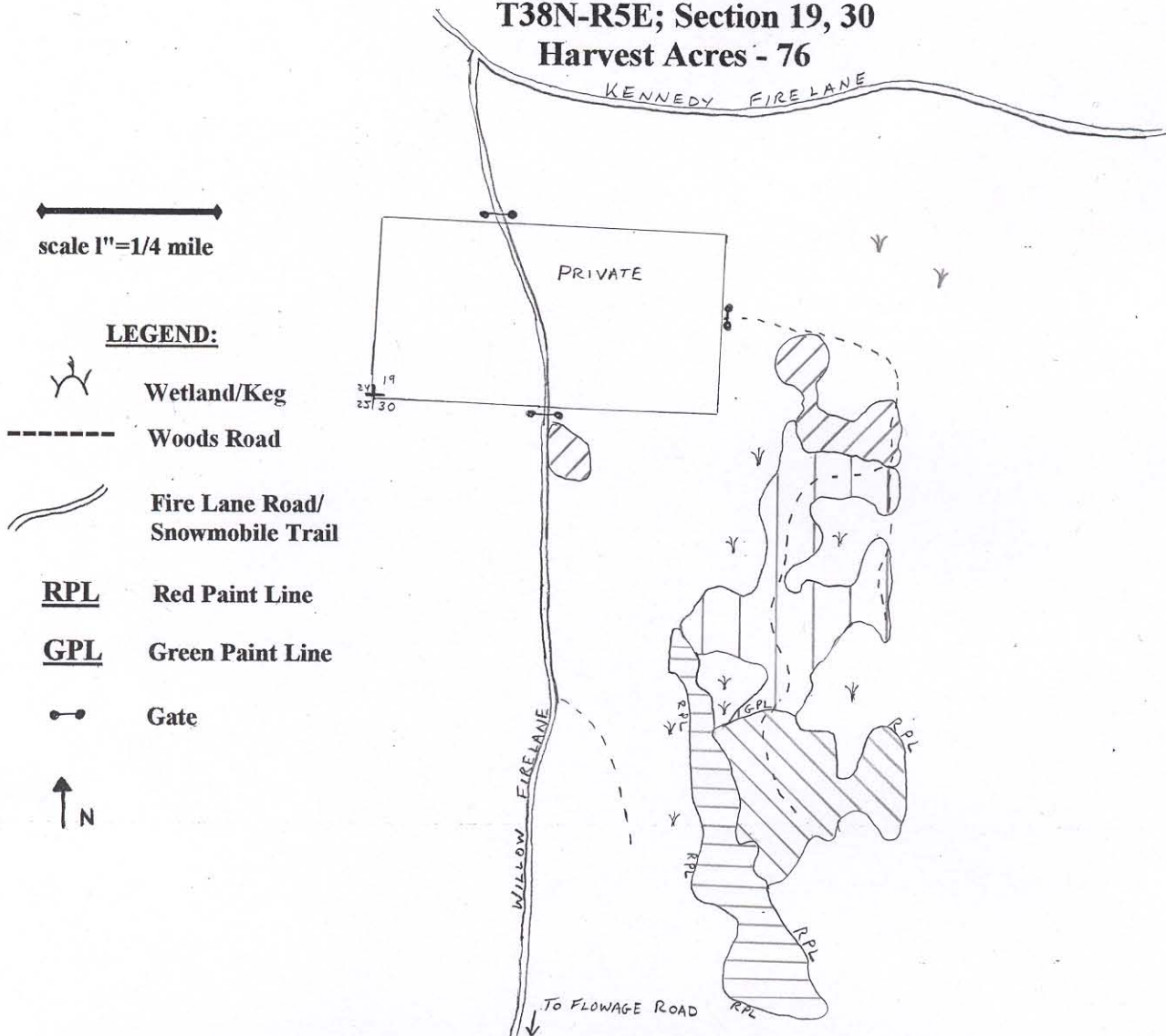

¹ Mixed Hardwood (4") includes approximately 52% birch, 37% black ash, and 11% red maple.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. (9)
2. All sale activity must take place on frozen or dry ground. (1)
3. All landings require prior approval. (17)
4. All trails and roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition. (17)
5. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees, including understory pine regeneration, must be avoided.
6. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed in areas adjacent to wetlands. (18)
 - A. No landings or new skid roads permitted within 100' of wetland's edge.
 - B. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.
7. All roads must be returned to their original condition. (17)
8. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lie within 2 feet of the ground. (15)

- All roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition.
- All activity must take place during frozen-ground conditions.
- Snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris and in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.



(30 acres) Aspen Regeneration Area: Cut all aspen, birch, red maple, and balsam (including 1-5"). Cut only those red pine, white pine, and spruce marked with orange paint.



(26 acres) Aspen Harvest Area: Cut all aspen, birch, red maple, and *merchantable* balsam. Cut only those red pine, white pine, and spruce marked with orange paint.



(8 acres) Pine Harvest Area: Cut all red and white pine marked with orange paint.



(12 acres) Swamp Hardwood Area: Cut all trees marked with orange paint.
