All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

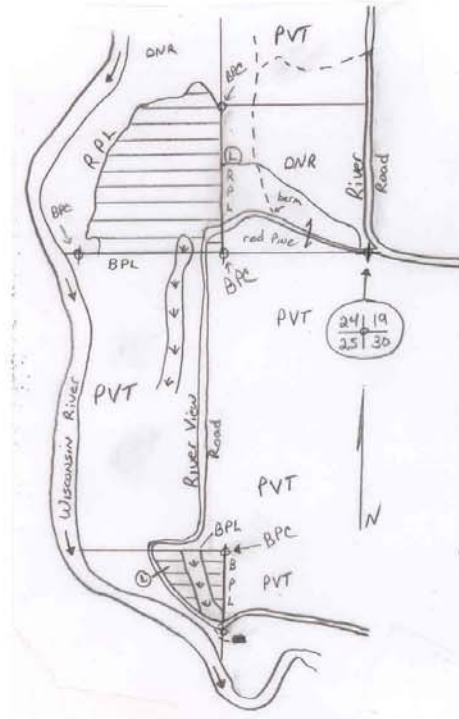
Special Conditions:

1. Harvest all aspen, white birch, balsam fir and maple one inch diameter and larger regardless of merchantability. Harvest all orange marked red pine. Harvest all jack pine with three or more pulp sticks. Do not harvest green paint marked legacy jack pine. Do not cut or damage scattered red pine, white pine, spruce, red oak, bur oak or green marked reserve trees.⁽⁹⁾
2. Damage to pine regeneration must be minimized.⁽⁹⁾
3. No equipment will be allowed to operate in any of the wet areas within or next to this sale area to prevent rutting. Soil rutting will be monitored and if rutting occurs additional restrictions will be imposed on the harvesting contractor.⁽¹⁸⁾
4. All trees felled into wet areas must be pulled back onto high ground before limbing and bucking occurs.⁽¹⁶⁾
5. No tops or slash allowed across any blue line.⁽¹⁶⁾
6. **If harvesting to a 2" top or whole tree utilization, every 10th tree top, the portion above the 4" standard pulpwood stick, must remain on the sale and be evenly scattered throughout the sale area to improve biomass retention for soil production and wildlife habitat.**⁽⁹⁾
7. Cutting dates are from June 1 to March 15.⁽⁹⁾
8. **No ground skidding allowed.**⁽⁹⁾

Harvest Area: Harvest all aspen, white birch, balsam fir and maple 1" diameter and larger. Harvest all jack pine with 3 or more pulp sticks. Do not harvest green paint marked legacy jack pine. Harvest all orange marked red pine. (9)

Do not cut or damage scattered red pine, white pine, spruce, red oak, bur oak or green marked trees. Damage to residual pine regeneration must be minimized. (A dozen or so bur oak are green marked along the west RPL to help you ID this unusual tree.) (9)

No ground skidding allowed. (9)
