The cutting area is approximately 192 acres.
The contract period is 2 year. All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized with the exception of white birch that yields two or more sticks within Area A.

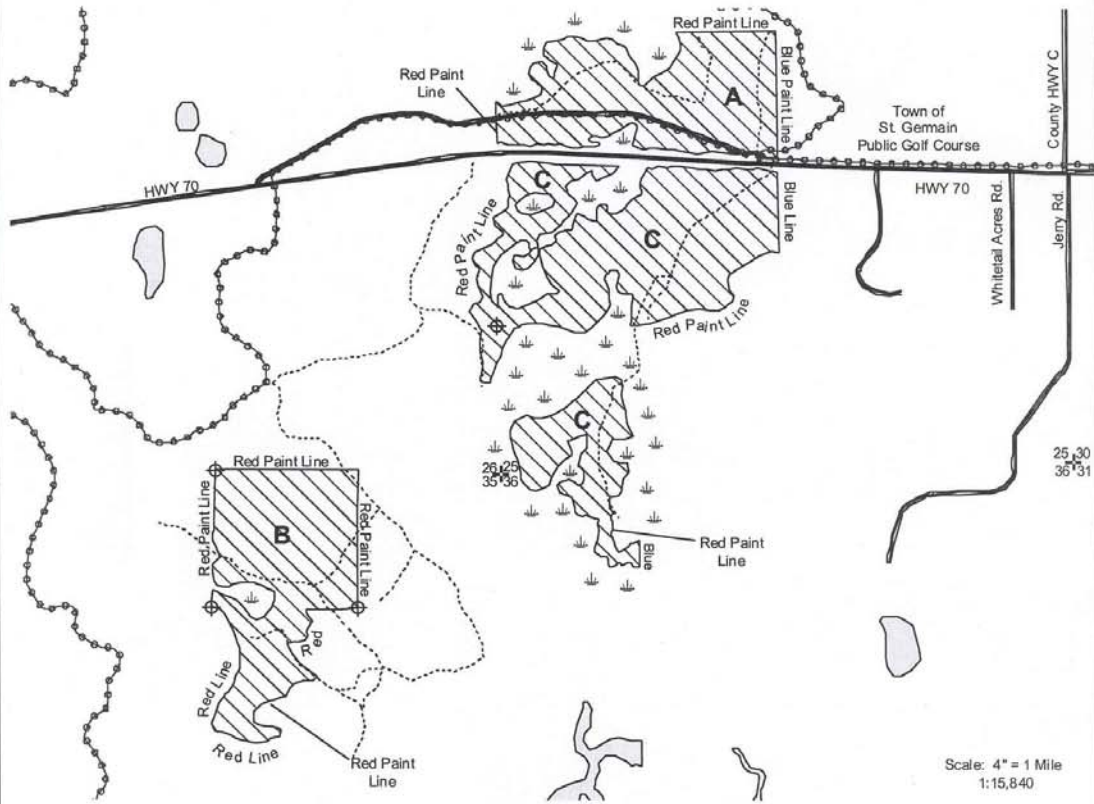

Special Conditions:

1. All pine products cut between June 1st. and September 1st. must be removed from the sale area within three weeks time of cutting. Pine products during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to June 1st. of each year.⁽³⁵⁾
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.⁽⁹⁾
3. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.⁽¹⁶⁾
4. All landings and any new roads must be approved by the timber sale administer. ⁽¹⁸⁾
5. **Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided including understory pine regeneration must be avoided.**⁽³⁵⁾
6. Equipment Restrictions: Skidding of forest product materials will be restricted to shortwood skidders only.⁽³⁵⁾
7. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times. Decking will be permitted along the snowmobile trail only between April 1 and November 15. All wood decked on the snowmobile trail must be removed by November 15. All trails must be restored to pre-harvest condition before the start of each season.⁽¹⁸⁾
8. Slash must be lopped and scattered within at least ten feet from snowmobile trails and pulled back behind tree line concurrently with cutting.⁽¹⁶⁾
9. Whole tree harvesting **will not** be permitted on this sale.⁽⁹⁾

 Selection Harvest Area/Pine Thinning (192 Acres): Cut all aspen, jack pine, oak, maple, balsam fir and orange marked trees. Cut all white birch down to 1-stick except within Area A where it is down to 2-sticks.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.
Minimize damage to oak and white pine seedlings/saplings within Area B
