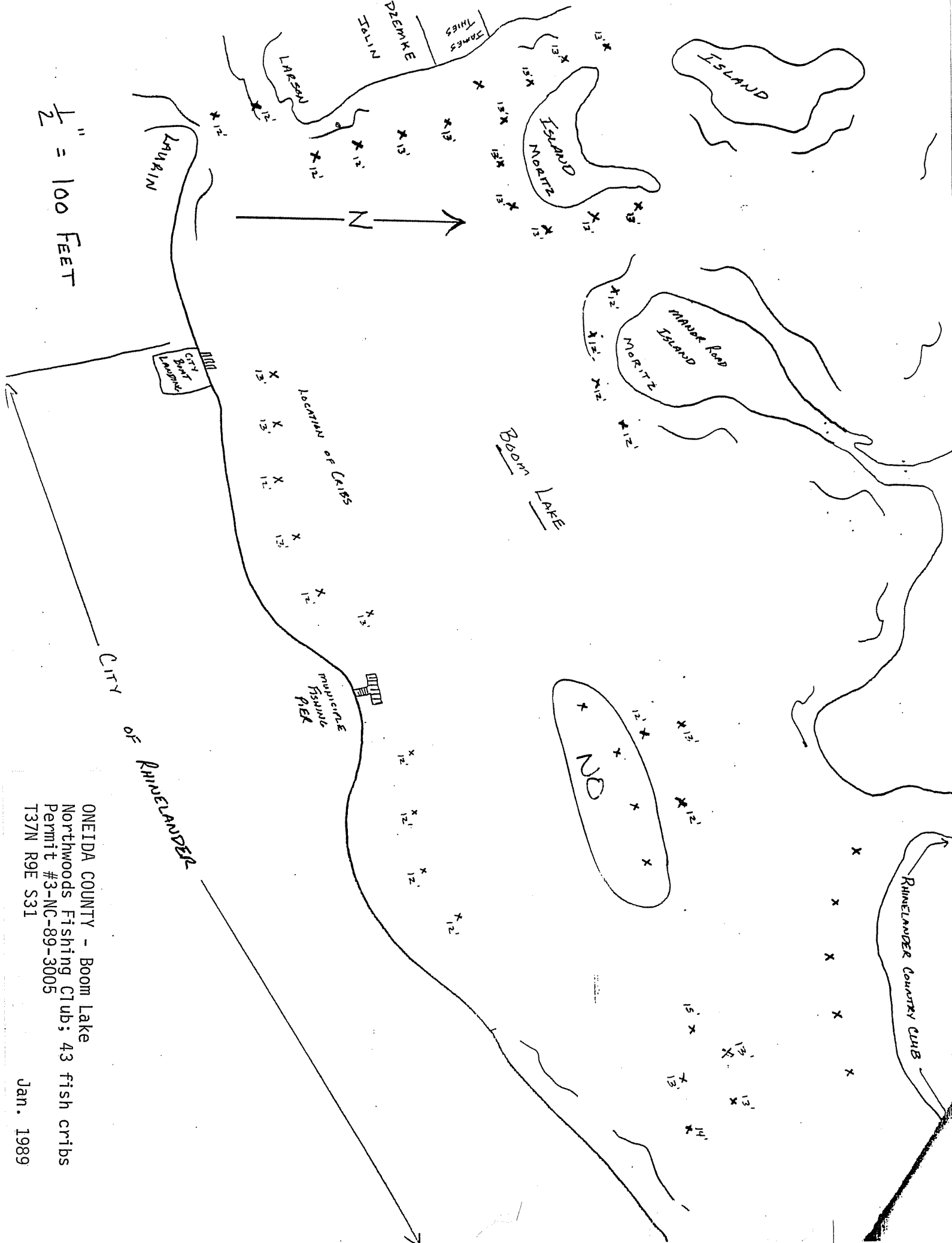

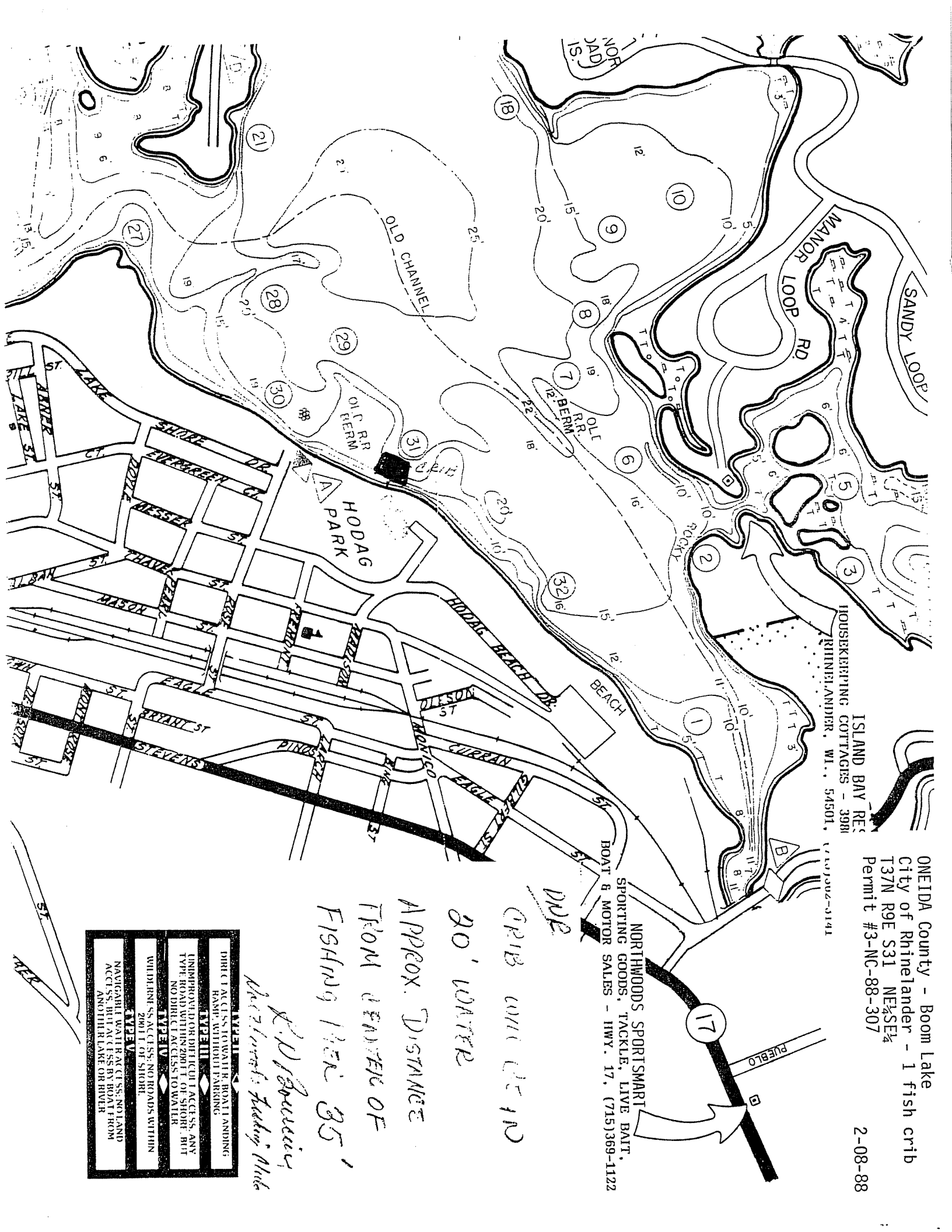

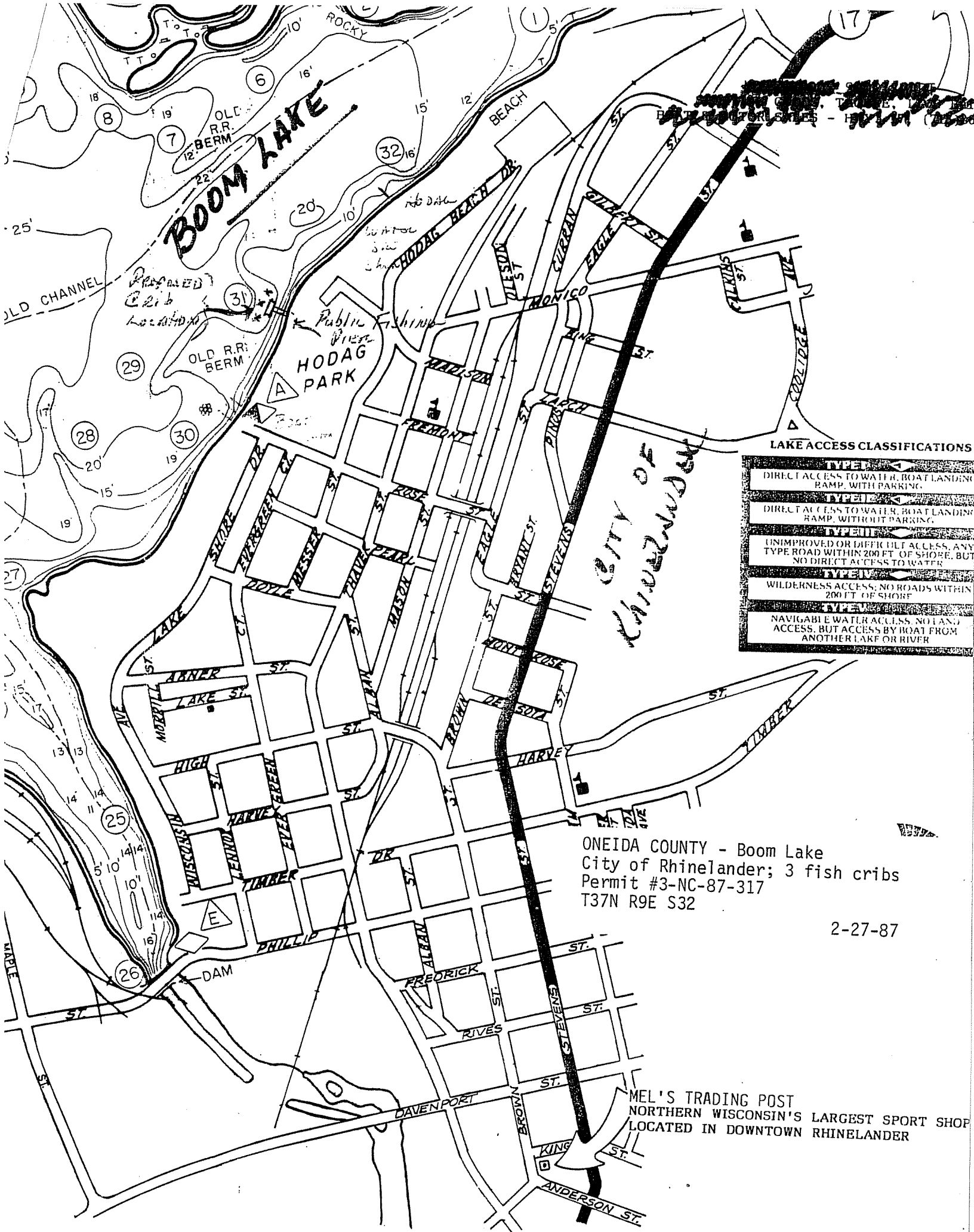

TYPE I	DIRECT ACCESS TOWARD BOAT LANDING RAMP WITHOUT FERRING
TYPE II	UNIMPROVED OR DIFFICULT ACCESS, ANY TYPE ROAD WITHIN 200 FT. OF SHORE, BUT NO DIRECT ACCESS TO WATER
TYPE III	WILDERNESS ACCESS; NO ROADS WITHIN 200 FT. OF SHORE
TYPE IV	NAVIGABLE WATER ACCESS; NOT LAND ACCESS, BUT ACCESS BY BOAT FROM ANOTHER LAKE OR RIVER



**LAKE ACCESS CLASSIFICATIONS**

- TYPE I** DIRECT ACCESS TO WATER, BOAT LANDING RAMP, WITH PARKING.
- TYPE II** DIRECT ACCESS TO WATER, BOAT LANDING RAMP, WITHOUT PARKING.
- TYPE III** UNIMPROVED OR DIFFICULT ACCESS, ANY TYPE ROAD WITHIN 200 FT. OF SHORE, BUT NO DIRECT ACCESS TO WATER.
- TYPE IV** WILDERNESS ACCESS; NO ROADS WITHIN 200 FT. OF SHORE.
- TYPE V** NAVIGABLE WATER ACCESS, NO LAND ACCESS, BUT ACCESS BY BOAT FROM ANOTHER LAKE OR RIVER.
