

## Public Notice of Air Pollution Permit Application Reviews

### Facility Description.

Calumet Superior, LLC, located at 2407 Stinson Avenue, Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, FID 816009590 [Refinery] and FID 816005080 [Terminal] submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) permit applications, including plans and specifications for construction permits for construction and operation of refinery components and changes to accommodate ethanol receiving using trucks at the marketing terminal with connection to ethanol tank T41, bulk terminal ethanol, biodiesel unloading project, biodiesel storage tank, and for a vacuum tower project to replace trays with structured packing, receive and process a new stream (atmospheric gas oil) from the crude tower, produce a new distillate stream directed to the #2 DUF process unit, and upgrade the #2 DUF unit.

### Application Review.
