

Public Notice of an Air Pollution Permit Application Review

Facility Description.

Louisiana-Pacific Corporation-Hayward, located at 16571 W US Highway 63, Hayward, Sawyer County, Wisconsin, FID 858100540, submitted to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) a permit application, including plans and specifications for construction and operation to reroute emissions from existing wood fired thermal oil heater stacks to dryer / process stacks controlled using, cyclones, a wet electrostatic precipitator and regenerative thermal oxidizer. Authorize upgrades to Line 1 press operations. . Air pollution construction permit no. 14-DCF-189, and permit 858100540-P12, revision of a Part 70 permit.

Application Review.

DNR has made a preliminary determination that the application meets state and federal air pollution control requirements and that the permit should be approved. This is a PSD (NR 405) Permit. It is revising a PSD PM / PM₁₀ BACT to authorize changes in the control devices but it is not increasing any of the allowable emissions such that there are no changes in increment consumption. A new PSD BACT is proposed for visible emissions (opacity).

The department has made the determination under ch. NR 150 that this type of proposal normally does not have the potential to cause significant adverse environmental or secondary effects. This preliminary determination does not constitute approval from the Air Management Program or any other DNR sections which may also require a review of the project.
