

Notice of Public Hearing by the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa on the Band's Proposal to Change the Air Quality Status of their Reservation from Class II to Class I

The Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa will hold a public hearing on Thursday, October 2, 2014, from 3 to 9 p.m., in the Otter Creek Room of the Black Bear Casino Resort located in Carlton, MN. The public hearing is on the Band's proposal to change the air quality status of their reservation located in northeastern Minnesota approximately 20 miles west of Superior, Wisconsin, from Class II to Class I under the federal Clean Air Act. A Class I designation would allow for more air quality protection than Class II. Almost all of Wisconsin and Minnesota is classified as Class II. Notice of the public hearing was provided to the state in an August 21, 2014 letter to Secretary Cathy Stepp of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
