NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
AND
ORDER FOR PUBLICATION

Gary Glojek, 6212 West Greenfield Avenue, West Allis, Wisconsin, applied to the Department of Natural Resources (the Department) to place a structure on the bed of Green Bay, Village of Ephraim, Door County, Wisconsin. The proposed project is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 31 North, Range 27 East, Village of Ephraim, Door County, Wisconsin. The applicant proposes to construct a 75 foot long groin that would be six feet wide at the top (above the water) and 21 feet wide on the bottom (on lakebed) to protect boats moored at a proposed pier that would be exempt. The groin is proposed to start approximately 45 feet waterward of the ordinary high water mark.

By letter dated February 12, 2013, the Department denied Gary Glojek's application.

On March 8, 2013, the Department received a petition for a contested case hearing from Gary A. Glojek.

On March 20, 2013, the Department granted the contested case hearing request. On July 12, 2013, the Division of Hearings and Appeals received the Request for Hearing from the Department.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State of Wisconsin Division of Hearings and Appeals will hold a public hearing pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 30.12, 30.209 and 227.42 commencing at **11:00 a.m. on October 2, 2013**, in Room C204 at the Door County Justice Center, 1201 South Duluth Avenue, Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin.

The hearing will be a Class 1 contested case pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.01(3)(a) and the fair play provisions of Wis. Stat. ch. 227 will apply. The procedures relating to contested cases set forth in Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 2 will be followed. The procedure that will be followed at the public hearing will closely resemble that normally followed at a court hearing. All parties are advised that they have the right to seek the aid and assistance of legal counsel and to be represented by legal counsel at the public hearing.
