NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING**

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) will hold a public informational meeting to gather public input on the potential installation of a second ozone monitor in Sheboygan County.

Background

The current Sheboygan ozone monitor is located along the lakeshore in Kohler-Andre State Park. The Kohler-Andre ozone monitor has historically measured nonattainment for the National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for ozone, including the 1997 8-hour standard, and the 2008 8-hour standard.

An appropriation for the set-up and operation of a second ozone monitor located in Sheboygan County for up to 2 years was included in the 2013-2015 biennial budget. WDNR has worked with local officials and concerned parties to identify a location further from the lakeshore and to the north of the City of Sheboygan to site the second ozone monitor.

The proposed location identified as a second ozone monitoring site in the County of Sheboygan is located at: N7563 State Highway 42, Town of Mosel, Sheboygan County.
