

**Summary of Public Comments Received About  
Department Proposal for development of a Program Guidance Document for the  
Public & Private Shooting Range Grant Program**

**A. Overview.** One (1) comment was received by the Department of Natural Resources during the 21-day public comment period. That comment was not about the Department's proposal to modify the Public & Private Shooting Range grant program by allowing sponsors of Public Shooting Ranges to apply for grant funding every 6 months instead of once every 12 months. Because Eligible Project Sponsors will include Individuals (Page 2 of Guidance doc), I'd suggest they be added to Section I, Applicant Information list (Page 8 of Guidance, Section 1). Also, what does the term Individual mean in terms of applying for a grant - I'm thinking about eligibility regs and how funds can't be used to benefit an individual or organization for gain. Thanks.
