

**Summary of Public Comments Received About Updates to the
"Bridge Guidelines for New and Replacement Snowmobile and All-Terrain Vehicle Bridges CF-005"**

A. Overview

On August 15, 2014, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) solicited comments from the public about its draft Bridge Guidelines. The deadline for comments was midnight on September 12, 2014. Two public comments were received; see summary below.

B. Summary of Comments

1. Brian Duell, Clark County Zoning Administrator commented: "Ruzic Construction is listed as a bridge contractor – they are no longer in business."

DNR Response: Ruzic Construction has been eliminated from the Bridge Contractor List.

2. Steve Janke, President, Janke General Contractors, Inc. commented that his company was not listed under the Bridge Manufacturer or Bridge Contractor list and that he would like to be listed. He further explained, "We build and install snowmobile and pedestrian bridges throughout Wisconsin & Minnesota. Janke has been doing this for 14 years. We build on average of 8 bridges per year. Could you please add us to both lists? If you need more information please contact me."

DNR Response: Janke General Contractors, Inc. has been added to both lists.

C. Summary of Changes

Only two comments both regarding lists of bridge contractors/manufacturers were received. Both comments were incorporated into the final *Bridge Guidelines for New and Replacement Snowmobile and All-Terrain Vehicle Bridges CF-005* and posted on the DNR's Snowmobile grant web page <http://dnr.wi.gov/Aid/SnowmobileTrails.html>.

D. Communication Efforts

In addition to posting the draft *Bridge Guidelines* on the DNR's program guidance web page, the Department also shared the draft *Bridge Guidelines* by email with County Snowmobile Coordinators and announced availability of the draft Bridge Guidelines for comment at the Governor's Snowmobile Recreation Council meeting on August 18, 2014.
