

Program Guidance - Malfunction Prevention and Abatement Plan (MPAP) Applicability

Summary of Changes Based on Public Comments

The guidance memorandum titled “Malfunction Prevention and Abatement Plan (MPAP) Applicability” was developed to clarify when MPAP requirements apply to air emission sources. One comment was received via e-mail during the public comment period suggesting that the department provide additional guidance on how to prepare a malfunction prevention and abatement plan for a process that does not include emission control equipment.

In response to this comment, department staff identified an MPAP for a source that has emission units both with and without control equipment. Rather than adding to the guidance document itself, that MPAP has been redacted to remove identifiable references to the emission source, and the redacted MPAP will be included as an example when the final guidance document is posted to the [air management guidance system](#). That system is accessible to both internal department staff, and members of the general public.
