

Public Input Process for Creating or Updating Guidance
Summary of Changes Based on Public Comments

Thank you to all of the individuals that provided feedback on the Department of Natural Resources (Department) proposed new guidance titled, “Used Oil Recycling for Handlers – Satisfying the Rebuttable Presumption”. Four e-mail comments were submitted to the Department during the public comment period. Included in this document are all of the public comments received.

The Department made the following changes based on the feedback:

1. This guidance document has been identified as an addendum to guidance document WA 233 Used Oil Management. Some sections have been rearranged and others removed.
2. The section on VSQG exempt hazardous wastes mixed with used oil will be clarified.
3. An explanation of how to use the list of halogenated hazardous constituents in US EPA Resources #3 Appendix B has been added.
4. Information on inorganic total halogen concentrations and use of organic total halogen concentrations for marine used oil to rebut the presumption had been added.
5. References to material safety data sheets (MSDS) are changed to safety data sheets (SDS).
6. Example 5 has been clarified to reflect the values in Table 1 of NR 679.
