

WELL ABANDONMENT GRANTS

Authorization: s. 281.75, Wis. Stats., and ch. NR 123, Wis. Admin. Code

Budget: 2012-2013 Fiscal Year = \$552,000 shared with Well Compensation Program.

Objective: To provide financial assistance for individuals to properly abandon unused private wells.

Eligible Claimant Must Meet All the Following:

- The landowner or landowners spouse, heir, assignee/legal representative, or renter.
- Prior calendar year family income was less than \$65,000.
- A private well(s) is located on your property that is unused and needs to be abandoned.

Level of Assistance: 75% of allowable costs, but not more than \$9,000. The amount of the grant is reduced by \$.30 for each \$1.00 of the applicant's annual family income over \$45,000.

Priorities: Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis until available funds are exhausted.

Eligible Cost: The well abandonment cost only, this grant reimbursement is for 75% of total cost for a maximum possible grant award of \$9,000:

- Properly abandoning the unused well;
- Other cost if deemed necessary and approved by the DNR Ground Water Program Manager.

The eligible cost amounts for these activities are set by DNR funding tables. Well abandonment work must be done according to DNR specifications and the unused private well must be properly abandoned and filled before payment will be made.

IMPORTANT: The costs for any work done before your application claim receives issuance of a grant award agreement or notice to proceed indicating DNR "Approval to Proceed" with the work to abandon your well are not eligible for a grant award.
