This landing will be ADA accessible and will provide access to the river and the upland urban areas. The City of Green Bay will use a combination of Recreational Boating Facilities (RBF) and Sport Fish Restoration (SFR) grant funds along with other funding to design, engineer, and construct all elements of the Cherry Street Landing (wood decking, substructure, lighting, cable bracing and pilings). Transient docks and finger piers will attach to the landing and will line 70% of the CityDeck area.

The project will also include an accessible path with an asphalt surface between the fishing pier and the parking lot. There is an existing boat launch in the park. The fishing pier will be a sufficient distance from the boat ramp so there is no user conflict between anglers on the pier and users of the boat ramp. Silver Lake is popular with anglers and currently has no accessible shore fishing spots.

There will also be a vault toilet, paved parking area and paved connector pathway.
