

TOWN AND COUNTY ROAD AIDS

Authorization: s. 20.370(7)(mc)

Budget: Fiscal Year 2010 approximately \$300,000
Fiscal Year 2011 unknown at this time

Objective: Provide funds to maintain the town and county roads that provide public use access to DNR recreation properties-parks, forests, recreation areas, the Lower Wisconsin River way and other DNR public use areas.

Eligibility: Towns, unincorporated villages and counties with roads located within the boundaries of any state park, forest, or for roads that provide the primary access to DNR properties.

Level of Assistance: Cost share is variable with up to 100% assistance depending upon priority and need.

Priorities:

- ◆ Legal or contract commitments.
- ◆ Volume of DNR property generated traffic versus local traffic.
- ◆ Level of road deterioration and safety concerns.
- ◆ Local cost-share.

Eligible Types of Projects: Road renovation, resurfacing, reconstruction and maintenance necessary to limit deterioration and maintain safe public use of town and county roads in or providing access to DNR public use areas.

Applications: A capital development request form (9300-197) signed by the property manager along with a letter of justification and a map depicting the road segment from town or county routed from DNR property manager to other required regional and bureau signatures to the Bureau of Facilities and Lands, Facilities Management Section.

History: This program has been unfunded for the last ten years. Since 1999.
