

Navigating Quick Tips

- Use the **Zoom In**, **Zoom Out** and **Move** buttons to view more (or less) detail on the map. You may also use your cursor to draw a box around a section of our statewide map and zoom in. *As you zoom in, more features will become available to you, such as quadrangle maps, roads, aerial photographs and water bodies.*
- Use the "**Find Location**" tool to quickly locate an area of interest. You can find sites in these applications by using the
 - *BRRTS activity number*
 - *City or Village*
 - *Township/Range/Section (Public Land Survey System)*
 - *County*
 - *Civil Town*
 - *Latitude/Longitude coordinates (D/M/S)*
 - *Latitude/Longitude coordinates (D/D)*
 - *UTM coordinates*
 - *WTM coordinates*
- To quickly learn to locate a site or information, use the "**Help**" tab or click on "**What Is RR Sites Map?**" to return to the Instructions.
- Click on the "**Themes**" tab to select the theme you wish to view, either
 - **Contaminated and Cleaned Up Sites**
 - **GIS Registry**
 - **Liability Limitations and Clarifications, or**
 - **DNR Financial Actions.**
- Click on the "**Layers**" tab to select different map layers to view.
- After zooming in to a specific location, click on the "**Identify/Site Info**" button and then click on the specific location on the map to get basic information on the selected site. This button will also provide links to more site-specific information :
 - BRRTS on the Web, for any site on all themes
 - View Database (BRRTS)

- the PDF (information packet) for a GIS Registry site
 - View Selected Docs (PDF).
- **Mouse-overs and Pop-ups:** For many items in this application, if you move the mouse over words or icons (shapes or pictures), a short explanation of the function or feature will pop up in a box on the screen. To get rid of the pop-up, just click on it again. Some are also opened by right-clicking the mouse, then opening the document that comes up on the screen. Words in blue are usually links to a different screen, more information or for an email address.
- **Active Button or Tab:** To see which white button is active, look below the map view, where the selected map tool is displayed. The white buttons are also outlined in gold when active. The blue tabs have the same (general) title displayed to the left of the map view when active.
- **Active Layers:** Certain layers come on automatically at a certain scale. Some of the automatic thresholds include:
 - Symbols for RR sites: 1:1,000,000
 - RR site labels: 1:40,000
 - Digital Ortho Photographs: 1:40,000
 - Polygons on: 1:50,000
 - Local roads: 1:150,000
 - Water layers: 1:1,000,000
