

Fee Worksheet (FW) Form

- FW Form calculates hazardous waste generator fees and is required for:
 - Large Quantity Generator (LQG)
 - Small Quantity Generator (SQG)
 - Treatment, Storage, Disposal Facility (TSD)
- Also required for Permanent Household and Very Small Quantity Generator Hazardous Waste Collection Facilities (that ship off-site to licensed or permitted TSD) to report amount of waste collected during report year
- FW Form Section A will display base fee information
 - Generator status during report year (from what was entered on Reporting Requirements screen)
 - Base fee for generator status reported

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Hazardous Waste Annual Report Fee Worksheet (FW) Form calculates hazardous waste generator fees and is required for sites that during the report year were a large quantity generator (LQG), small quantity generator (SQG) or treatment/storage/disposal (TSD) facility. It is also the required form for permanent household and very small quantity generator hazardous waste collection facilities that ship hazardous waste off-site to a licensed or permitted hazardous waste TSD facility to report the amount of waste collected during the report year.

The FW Form has two main sections, and a third section that is only displayed for permanent collection facilities required to report. Section A displays the hazardous waste generator status that was entered for the site on the reporting requirements screen in the column for the report year. The corresponding base fee for the generator status reported will be displayed below the status.

Fee Worksheet (FW) Form (cont.)

- Section B Question 1—report total amount (in pounds) of hazardous waste generated during report year
- Section B Question 2—report any amounts of the waste generated that would be applicable for tonnage fee exemption in any of four categories described in 2a, 2b, 2c and 2d
- Permanent Household and Very Small Quantity Generator Hazardous Waste Collection Facilities required to report will have Section C displayed for entry of the total amount of waste collected (as this type of facility) in the report year

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Section B requests information about the quantities of hazardous waste generated and managed by specific methods during the report year. All amounts must be reported in pounds. For Question 1, report the total quantity of hazardous waste generated. In Section B Question 2, report amounts of the waste from Question 1 that would be eligible for tonnage fee exemption in any of the four categories described in 2a, 2b, 2c and 2d.

Section C will be displayed for permanent household and very small quantity generator hazardous waste collection facilities that ship hazardous waste off-site to a licensed or permitted hazardous waste TSD facility to report the amount of waste collected during the report year as this type of facility. If the site was not involved in other hazardous waste activities and was not a generator, then zero should be entered in Section A for the amount of waste generated.

Fee Worksheet (FW) Form (cont.)

- FW Form no longer used to collect waste minimization activity data from large quantity generators
- Enter comments in the Comments section of the screen
- Click the Save FW Form button
- Hazardous waste generator fees will be determined from FW Form data reported (base fee + applicable tonnage fees)
- **Do not send fee to DNR at this time**

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Large quantity generators no longer report information about their site's waste minimization activities on the FW Form. This information is now collected on the Waste Generation and Management (GM) Form for each waste type generated.

Enter comments in the Comments section of the screen to clarify any FW Form information. Click the Save FW Form button when entry on this screen is complete.

The DNR uses the FW Form information to assess a hazardous waste generator fee. The estimated fee (base fee + tonnage fees) will be shown on the screen. The hazardous waste generator fee will be shown on the environmental fee statement sent to your facility in early June.

We ask that you do not send the fee until after you receive the environmental fee statement.

An example of the FW Form completed by a small quantity generator is shown above. The base fee for a small quantity generator is displayed under the generator status. The response to Section B Question 1 shows the amount of waste generated. Exemptions from tonnage fees are applicable for part of the waste generated by this site, and are noted in Questions 2a and 2c. The total estimated hazardous waste generator fee is calculated by adding the base fee and the applicable tonnage fees.

Comments

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Another example shows the FW Form completed by a large quantity generator. The base fee for a large quantity generator is displayed under the generator status. The response to Section B Question 1 shows the amount of waste generated. An exemption from tonnage fees is applicable for part of the waste generated by this site, and is noted in Questions 2a. Base fee + tonnage fees = the total hazardous waste generator fee. Large quantity generators no longer report waste minimization data on the FW Form.

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Example of FW Form screen completed by a permanent household and very small quantity generator hazardous waste collection facility that ships hazardous waste off-site to a licensed or permitted hazardous waste TSD facility. As a non-generator, the base fee is not applicable to this site. For Section B Question 1, zero has been entered so tonnage fees are not applicable either. The site uses Section C to enter the amount of waste collected during the report year as a permanent collection facility.
