

Waste Generation and Management (GM) Form

- GM Form not used for 2008 (or for any “short report” year)
- GM Form is required (only for odd-numbered report years) for large quantity generators of hazardous waste and for treatment, storage, disposal facilities (TSDs)

The Waste Generation and Management (GM) Form is divided into three sections that together document: the quantity, source and characteristics of hazardous waste generated on-site; the quantities of hazardous waste managed on-site and the on-site management methods used; and the quantities of hazardous waste shipped off-site, where it was shipped and the off-site management methods used.

The information on the GM Form is only collected for odd-numbered report years (sometimes called “long report” years), and is only required of large quantity generators and treatment, storage, disposal facilities. Upon completion of the Reporting Requirements screen in the Web Reporting System, the forms required for the current report year will be listed for the reporting site.

The GM Form is not required for any sites for the 2008 report year.
