

## **Public Notice on a Letter of Intent to Participate in Tier 2 of Green Tier**

Pursuant to Section 299.83, Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) hereby gives notice that DNR has received a letter of intent to participate in Tier 2 of Green Tier from Lucas-Milhaupt, located at 5656 S Pennsylvania Ave, Cudahy, Milwaukee County, WI 53110. Lucas-Milhaupt is a complete source for metal joining products and services, such as alloys, fluxes, automated equipment, product design, training and technical assistance. Under Green Tier, Lucas-Milhaupt will reduce, with the goal of ultimately eliminating, the last of their VOC sources in the production area, will create a dust collection system for dust coming off of the flattening mills and will reduce plastic spool waste. Though Lucas-Milhaupt is seeking Tier 2 status, they will not be seeking any regulatory flexibility from the DNR in the contract that will be negotiated.

### **Opportunity for public to comment or request a public meeting**

DNR will accept written comments from the public regarding the letter of intent through Friday, December 15, 2006. Comments may be submitted to Tom Eggert (see above).

Also within the 30-day comment period, individuals may request a public informational meeting concerning this letter of intent by submitting a written request to the DNR contact. If DNR determines there is significant interest in this letter of intent, DNR will hold a public informational meeting.
