

Public Notice on a Proposed Participation Contract under Tier II of Green Tier

Pursuant to Section 299.83, Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) hereby gives notice that DNR has reached tentative agreement on a proposed participation contract under Tier II of Green Tier with Lucas-Milhaupt Inc, 5656 S. Pennsylvania Ave, Cudahy, WI 53110. Lucas-Milhaupt is a manufacturing company making brazing materials along with the pastes and fluxes used in the metal joining process. Their EMS runs parallel with their safety program, rewarding employees for creating innovative objectives for environmental improvement. Current proposed goals include a dust collection system and reducing what few VOCs they generate. Though Lucas-Milhaupt is seeking Tier 2 status, they have not requested any regulatory flexibility from the DNR in their contract.

Opportunity for public to comment or request a public meeting

DNR will accept written comments from the public regarding the proposed participation contract through May 22, 2007. Comments on the proposed participation contract may be submitted to Tom Eggert (see above).

Also within the 30-day comment period, individuals may request a public informational meeting concerning this proposed participation contract by submitting a written request to the DNR contact. If DNR determines there is significant interest in this proposed contract, DNR will hold a public informational meeting.

How DNR will make final decisions

DNR will enter into the proposed participation contract as early as 30 days after publication of this notice unless a public informational meeting is requested, or DNR and the applicant agree to an extension, or information is brought to light suggesting that the proposed participation contract is not in the best interest of the Green Tier program. A decision by DNR to enter into a participation contract under Tier II of Green Tier is not subject to review under state laws governing contested case hearings, but is subject to judicial review.
